Liverpool's city centre hidden gem, Queens, is celebrating its 5th birthday! The charming wine bar and bistro, located on the picturesque Queen Avenue just off Castle Street, is quite possibly the definition of a hidden gem — unassuming and situated off the beaten track.



Open 7 days a week and serving quality breakfasts, lunch specials, a seasonal a la carte menu, sublime Sunday roasts and an ever evolving specialist wine list, you can make yourself at home at Queens any time or any day of the week. Described by some as akin to a Parisian backstreet bistro, you could be forgiven for losing yourself and completely forgetting you're in Liverpool city centre.



Whilst life happens at a frantic pace on Castle Street and Dale Street, things are far more relaxed on Queens Avenue — with artisan business including a wine shop and an art gallery. This is where you'll find Queens

 one of Liverpool's best kept secrets that offers a warm and intimate dining area, a great atmosphere, a cool private dining space in the basement and a welcoming team.



At Queens you'll find a carefully curated and refined menu that's constantly evolving — featuring breakfasts and specials such as steak and eggs, lunches such as pork belly and steak frites and a la carte dishes such as cod loin and ricotta. Meanwhile, neighbouring specialist wine shop R & H Fine Wines supply the selection of wines and their Sunday roasts are simply sublime!



Speaking of their 5 year anniversary, Co-Owner Lucas said: "Five years ago we opened on a hidden city centre backstreet and when you're not on the high street with natural footfall, you have to work extra hard to get a name for yourself. People weren't going to just come to us."

He continued: "To open 7 days a week when you're hidden away from the rest of the

city centre is going against the odds, but fortunately our quality has shone through. Once people come here for the first time they most usually return and tell others about us — it feels great to still be here after 5 years."



Nestled away on a secluded and quaint boulevard, away from the hustle and bustle of the city centre, Queens is a place to escape to and forget about the stresses of day to day life. Charming and charismatic yet not pretentious, it has become a favourite of many who have discovered it.



One diner recently said: "This little restaurant offers beautifully cooked dishes accompanied with fine wine. We tried cauliflower steak, pan fried cod, pork belly and chicken. 





Events 471 aims to be a 'game changer' for the local music scene and far more than just an events brand. Led by mother and son team, Carol Hetherington and Carrick Moran, the idea is to offer local artists 360-degree support — paying them fairly and offering support with photo and video content, social media and more.

What's more, a C.I.C. has also been set up to create projects that will support artists further. 471 Routes C.I.C. is all about broadening its mission to help not just musicians but everyone within the creative industry. There's a strong team behind 471 Routes C.I.C. who are determined to make a change to music, art, and culture across the Liverpool City Region.



Since forming in January 2023, Events 471 has worked with 50 different artists and bands. Each receives a fair split of ticket sales, additional photography and videography, social media support, and a platform on the Events 471 website. The project covers all genres, with inclusivity and diversity at its heart, and there have been some amazing success stories with artists they've worked with.



Linking the best local up-and-coming talent with national and international acts, Events 471 have been a key stepping stone for many local artists and bands. There have been many packed shows at venues such as Future Yard, Start Yard, Northern Powerhouse and Molly's Chambers — with big headliners such as Anika Nilles, Queer House Party, The Beggs Sisters, Everything Yes and Xander & The Peace Pirates.

Events 471 have some big shows coming up such as Summer Soltice at Birkenhead Cricket Club on Fri 21st June featuring the legendary funk outfit Precinct 47, Helen Downey, Grool and DJ No Bed. Meanwhile, Soul Purpose is coming to The Lighthouse Church in Heswall on Sat 22nd June — an evening of soul for Claire House and Wirral MS Society featuring Soul City Voices and Night Shift Collective.

On Sat 29th June, Liverpool's fourpiece

psych-rock outfit BITE are headlining at Future Yard with support from Urban Hours and Sling. To cap off the summer, there's a Lunar Pull Album Party at Future Yard on Fri 5th July — a leftfield Indie rock showcase featuring their latest material. There are also monthly jazz and spoken word nights at Start Yard in Birkenhead, where their office is based.

Events 471's Carol said: "Events 471 came from a dinner table conversation and we decided to just go for it! We chatted about how it's hard for people to break into the music industry and get work experience. If you do, it's usually for very little or no money. We also spoke about Live music and how people do want to see local bands and artists but it's not very accessible and we want to change that."

She continued: "There are definitely gaps that need to be filled and more opportunities needed. We want to bridge the gap between the Liverpool and Wirral scenes (471 is a bus route between Liverpool and Wirral) and also gives up and coming artists the chance to perform alongside big names. We also want to be more than just an events company — supporting artists in many ways and helping them develop."

Events 471 consists of Carol, her son Carrick who is a talented local musician in his own right, Imogen and a wider team of people who are passionate about music and supporting creatives. Drawing in crowds of 100+ to support local artists and bands that people might not have heard of is a difficult task, but thanks to a collaborative approach all Events 471 gigs so far have been very successful.

Carrick explained: "It really is a team

effort and we try to pull artists and bands together to all help promote shows. All 23 gigs at Future Yard, Start Yard, Molly's Chambers and Northern Powerhouse have been amazing and we have an exciting programme for the rest of 2024 — with some really big hitters coming to perform with local talent."

A recent report from Music Venues Trust stated that the number of gigs at UK grassroots music venues was 16.7% lower than in 2019. Audience numbers were also at 89% of their 2019 level and 66 venues had closed during the past 12 months. With many factors such as the cost of living and Brexit impacting grassroots music, projects such as Events 471 are vital to bridge the gap.

Carol summarised: "How many talented musicians are there out there who haven't made it due to lack of opportunity? We must remember that all the top artists and bands started on their local scene. We want to provide opportunities and help local artists and bands raise their profile, but also help musicians develop as people too. In turn, we hope that this will also support the regeneration of Birkenhead."



Nestled away on Roman Road, just off Prenton Dell Road, The Saddle Club is a family run venue that's oozing with character and charm and has an inclusive policy. The venue is so old it was listed in the original Doomsday Book and offers a gorgeous space and garden to the rear for special occasions.



The venue was taken on by Paul & Isobel Swift in 1999 and the pair have hosted in the region of 25,000 events and weddings there — from funerals to parties to weddings. When the same sex marriage laws changed shortly after they took it over, The Saddle Club became one of the first venues in the North West to officially offer same sex marriages and was featured in Pink Pages.











During the past 25 years, the venue has won many awards such as Most Unique Venue & Service, Wakes & Life Celebration Venue and Proprietor Of The Year awards. The venue caters for people from all walks of life and backgrounds and the latest LGBTQ+ award is in recognition of their dedication to LGBTQ+ weddings. It comes in a timely manner, as Paul looks back on the past 25 years of serving the public.



Paul explained: "It's been an amazing 25 years and it fills us with joy to think of all the special occasions and memories that have been made here. Looking back, we've worked out that we've hosted around 25,000 events and weddings — quite staggering really when you think about it! It's a big extended family here and some people who have celebrated their 18th, 21st, 40th birthdays and then their child's Christenings here."

He continued: "We have a great team and our General Manager Leah has been

here for years after becoming one of the youngest licensees in the region. We pride ourselves on treating people like our own and always go the extra mile for people, providing bespoke events tailored to any budget. We also have a policy of absolute inclusivity that we're really proud to have won awards for."



The Saddle Club also offers a very unique kind of wedding. Interestingly, The Saddle Club is also the only venue in England and Wales to offer Blacksmiths weddings over the anvil. The romantic tradition of Blacksmith's weddings involve 'tying the knot' — with the bang of a Blacksmith's anvil sealing the deal — bringing back the traditional, historical way of getting married.



Paul said: "We've made a great name for ourselves here which is really important considering we're hidden away off the beaten track. You wouldn't know we're here so it's important that we have a great reputation. The awards are really important and something we're really proud of — receiving the latest one on our 25 year anniversary here is the icing on the cake."



In this new La Vida Liverpool feature, guest writer and historian David Hearns educates us on some fascinating local history. With a wealth of knowledge, David gives talks and walking tours on subjects such as the history of Liverpool, wars, slavery, maritime, Liverpool's links with America and more. In this feature he talks us through the growth, decline and re-birth of New Brighton....



In the 70 years from 1830 to 1900, New Brighton grew from being virtually uninhabited into one of the most popular seaside resorts in Britain.

In 1830 James Atherton, a Liverpool merchant and property developer, agreed to buy 170 acres of land that was basically nothing more than sand dunes with a fort, a lighthouse and a few cottages, with a view to turning it into a desirable residential area for wealthy Liverpool business people.



Within three years of Atherton buying the land, a steam paddle-wheel ferry service was introduced from Liverpool to what was starting to be called New Brighton after Brighton, the famous South coast watering hole. This ferry service made it possible for people to live in New Brighton but commute daily to their work in Liverpool and was the catalyst that led to the growth of the area.

Initially it was just the wealthy who bought plots from James Atherton and later his sonin-law William Rowson had fine villas built looking out over Liverpool Bay. A number of these houses remain in Wellington Rd, North Drive and Montpellier Crescent.



From these humble beginnings the area started to grow into not only a residential area but somewhere that people from the crowdy, noisy, smelly streets of Liverpool could come and enjoy the fresh sea air. A pleasure pier was opened in 1867 and other catering and entertainment venues followed.



In the late 1880s the Wirral Railway reached the growing resort which enabled visitors from further afield to both visit and stay but it also enabled bricks to be brought into the area which enabled both faster and cheaper construction of houses and New Brighton started to become an accessible area for many Liverpool workers.



In 1880 The Palace, which offered fairground type attractions, a grotto, a small zoo, an open air skating area and exhibitions, opened. By the 1882 summer season an average of 10,000 visitors per day visited The Palace. The venue was redesigned in the early 1930s and reopened as The New Palace which is still open daily during the summer.

Theatres opened followed by cinemas and a section of the promenade became known as "The Ham and Egg Parade" where the "fast food" of the period was offered by a number of cafes. The promenade from Seacombe to New Brighton was opened in 1901, extended in 1907 and again in the 1930s until New Brighton boasted having the longest promenade in Britain.



In 1891 a Tower had been built in Blackpool and by 1896 a company had been formed to build a similar Tower although even taller in New Brighton. Work started in 1896 and by the time it was completed in 1899 it was the tallest structure in Britain. The Tower and Tower Grounds, became a major part of the resort's appeal to visitors.

At the start of WWI New Brighton Tower was closed to the public for the duration of the war and by 1919 the construction had suffered considerably from lack of maintenance so the decision was taken to demolish it although this was not completed until 1921. However the Tower Building was still fully operation with a ballroom that could accommodate 3,000 dancers. In addition there was also a theatre and a zoo.



The grounds around the building remained and were ultimately extended to provide a funfair including a roller coaster, a cable car to the roof of the building, a big wheel and a "wall of death" where motorcyclists hurtled around a vertical wall at speeds of up to 50mph.

The interior of the ballroom was destroyed by fire in 1956 but it was completely restored and in June 1961 the Beatles played there to 4,000 people for the first of what would ultimately be 27 visits making it second only to The Cavern in Liverpool for the number of Beatles concerts in Britain. Gerry and the Pacemakers, Rory Storm and the Hurricanes, Little Richard and The Rolling Stones were among other groups who performed at The Tower.



In the 1930s when the promenade was extended an outdoor bathing pool was also constructed that was the largest outdoor swimming pool in Europe and, some say, the world. During the first four months after the opening the pool attracted almost one million bathers and spectators. The pool went on to host "Bathing Beauty" competitions and pop music concerts.



After WWII as more people could drive and had cars New Brighton started to suffer a slow decline. The pace of the decline accelerated in the 1960s with cheap flights to Spain and other places where sunshine was more guaranteed than North West England. The Tower Buildings were destroyed by fire in 1969, the Pier, which had been reduced to an amusement arcade, closed in 1972 and was demolished in 1977.

The one time resort failed to attract holidaymakers and even the number of daytrippers reduced following the closure and subsequent demolition of the swimming pool in 1990. A couple of developers failed bring their plans to fruition and the Local Authority replaced half of Victoria Road, which had once boasted a theatre, with residential property.





More businesses left the area and by 2018 much of Victoria Rd was boarded up or derelict until the locally born successful businessman, Dan Davies, formed Rockpoint Leisure and injected £8 million of his own money into breathing new life into the town by re-opening closed businesses and funding many community led improvements as well as creating Britain's largest outdoor gallery of street art.



New Brighton, the town that grew and prospered only to decline and very nearly become a purely residential area, has been reborn and is now once again an area for visitors as well as an incubator for young local people to thrive in music and the arts.



One of the key businesses of Rockpoint Leisure, who have transformed the area with street art and independents, Rockpoint Records has been a go-to destination for music lovers since opening in 2019. With its stripped back brick walls, retro decor, great playlist, live music, record store, tattoo parlour, barbers, cocktail lounge and secret courtyard, it's established itself as one of the coolest bars in Wirral.



Many great nights have been had at the legendary venue, such as the epic gig from big hitters The Mysterines (two of whom have worked there), and countless top local artists have performed there. As the venue

celebrates its 5th year spearheading 'The Victorian Quarter', it has now added jerk chicken from Jerk It, woodfired pizzas from Hella Dough and a pool table to its list of reasons to visit.



Since being introduced recently, the Hella Dough woodfired pizzas have been flying out — with their crispy base, soft dough and create your own option winning over locals. Jerk It's mouthwatering chicken has also been a bit hit, as has the new pool table in the upstairs vinyl record store, whilst there's still Open Mic Thursdays, live music on Friday and Saturdays and monthly Rock N Roll Bingo.



Manager Sue Birkett said: "Whether you come in for a coffee in the daytime or for a few drinks and live entertainment in the evening, there's always a good vibe at Rockpoint Records. We have something for everyone and it's become a real community hub and meeting place for so many people. It's a great place to hang out or sit outside the front or secret courtyard at the back."

She continued: "The jerk chicken and pizzas have been really popular and everyone loves a game of pool — there's so much on offer here now. I don't think many places can say they have front and back outdoor seating, a cocktail lounge, a piano, an upstairs pool room and record store, an in house tattoo artist, barbers, regular live entertainment, chicken and woodfired pizzas. It really is the place to be!"



The Victoria Road area of New Brighton is going from strength to strength since the Rockpoint Leisure regeneration project. Coupled with the colourful street art, independent businesses are flourishing and recent additions such as Tallulah's, The Good Hood and Social 114 have made the street's offering even more attractive.



Rockpoint Leisure's Founder Daniel Davies said: "We've put everything into making this a great place to live and visit. 



My wife and I finally woke up to the opportunity New Brighton offers about 6 months ago. Our friend Daniel Davies had been banging the drum for quite a while. Dan was simply doing what he has done since 2019 - rallying people around the cause. He is dedicated to redeveloping and re invigorating this seaside town; his home town; that, like so many British seaside towns, has been subject to decades of dereliction by successive councils, governments and the allure of foreign travel.



New Brighton is different though, not just because of the tireless work and investment of Dan and his allies but because bit by bit, person by person and business by business, people have woken up to the fact that this seaside town has not only moved forward but that geography alone means there isn't a seaside town with a better chance of a bright future.

I ask you - which other seaside town is but 15 minutes by car or 25 minutes by train or bus from the centre of a city such as Liverpool?

But don't just take my word for it -- New Brighton was included in a recent Sunday Times Top Places to Invest in the UK and Victoria Quarter was the central reason for this. Rough Guides also list New Brighton Beach as one of the best beaches but you should come see The Victoria Quarter and the beach and experience it for yourself - I am pretty sure you will be hooked too whether as a tourist, a potential community member, a business or an investor.

Centred on Victoria Road, this is the hub of New Brighton and its regeneration has created a special vibe. It has by design got a wonderfully independent feel, peppered by art installations which may just be the finest outside art gallery in the world. The street art was one of the place building strategies adopted by Dan who attracted and funded street artists from around the world. A gift which we can all now enjoy.



The sense of community is evident as you wander from eatery to eatery, bar to bar and shop to shop. The alfresco dining and drinking makes a big difference to so much more than just the street scene as does the regular live music curated for visitors and locals alike at Rockpoint Records or Tallulahs's Emporium which also offers live Jazz, vintage HiFi DJ's spinning Soul or a fabulous cocktail.

Drinkers are well catered for at Rockpoint Records, The JA (The James Atherton), The Bow Legged Beagle or Homebrew Tap to name drop a few. When it comes to food there are plenty of food choices whether you fancy fish & chips, breakfast, brunch, a Sunday Roast at The Olive Tree, a spot of lunch or an evening meal there is something for you. Grab a touch of Americana from The Good Hood and street artists are now joined by street food with the offerings from Hella Dough and Jerk-It not to be missed.



I am also eagerly awaiting the new addition from Baltic Triangle Founder and Liverpool icon Jayne Casey. Jayne has returned to her roots and is bringing not just her expertise to the party but her business friends.



Victoria Quarter is at the centre of this delightful Victorian built corner of the Wirral Peninsula, it is the hub of the community, a place for the independent, a visual masterpiece of street art and a great place to relax and socialise. It is also by a fabulous beach, a pretty unparalleled seaside pedestrian promenade, the wonderful Vale Park and the fact that it's spitting distance from Liverpool City Centre, Anfield, Goodison and Aintree.

A lot has changed here - it's a place on the up and up and you will be made to feel very welcome as we have been.







An Overdue Introduction

There's this guy, I've seen him around Old Swan for perhaps approximately 25 years, he's a great big tall fella. When he was younger, he looked like a James Bond villain. He would seem to many a little surly, as he wasn't the friendly type. He always seemed flustered and avoidant of eye contact.

As a male, especially one with the background I have, sometimes you look at fellas and think: He'd be a handful if he turned. I suppose it's natural to assess threats, especially with his behaviour seeming a little erratic, and him being so large. He'd talk to himself at times and seemed to have strange ways of moving.

As the years have gone by he's changed, he seems to have lost weight, become more 'tall-thin' than 'big and imposing'. I think somebody looked after him once upon a time, maybe a parent or family member, and at some point, some time ago, they left him all alone. I think this because he started to not look after himself properly; his clothes became dirty and his teeth started to crack; he took on a bereft and dishevelled look.

And as the years have slowly ebbed away, and as I've traded my youthful ignorance for sagacity, I've realised that this was never anybody potentially dangerous, but a man who needs a little more help with life than most of us do. A man who faces certain challenges that have probably never been picked up on or diagnosed.

When I was younger, I viewed him as a potential threat (an unknown quantity) but now I see quite clearly that he's just a lost soul. I went from being weary of him to feeling sorry for him. I'd worry about him sometimes when I saw him, with each increment of social decline I witnessed I'd think: God bless ya, lad. I'd think about how so many people of that generation with special needs fell through the gaps in society's safety net.

Today I was walking through Old Swan and one of the cars at the lights must have had Classic FM on. There was this gorgeous solo violin piece playing, and as I looked up, as I scanned across the cars to see who would be playing classical music full blast out of a car window on the mean streets of Old Swan, I couldn't see the car or driver in question. But there, there on the other side of the road I saw him.

It was him, wasn't it? Busking with this old tatty violin, playing so perfectly it could have been a grand master. I walked over to watch him for a while, I was so moved I nearly dropped a tear. He was absolutely amazing. In-between each piece he'd stomp up and down and say: "Come on, come on!" As if getting himself ready for a fight. I wondered if this may have been why nobody was watching, maybe people found his self-soothing needs a little scary.

I stood there for a while, and when he saw me smiling, he smiled too. We finally held eye contact after such a long time; we found a way to seeing each other. I think he might have needed the acknowledgement today. I think he needed to show people how beautifully he could play, today he needed to be seen by somebody.

Later we talked and I asked him if he was taking donations (as he didn't seem to have a bowl) and he said: "People can just put the money on that piece of cardboard there." I looked down and he was pointing at what looked like a piece of rubbish on the floor that gave no indication that it was a collection plate at all, and I thought: You've not earned a fucking bean here all day, have you lad?

I passed him a fiver and he got so excited he actually kissed me on the head when he hugged me. He ecstatically pushed the note into his wallet. And we talked for a while, and I told him how talented he was, and after 25 years I learnt his name, and that people shouldn't really fear him, and that he plays violin beautifully. Today we finally met each other as humans.

In this exclusive interview, we talk to broadcasting legend Billy Butler. From DJing at The Cavern back in the day to hugely popular shows on BBC Radio 2, BBC Radio Merseyside and Radio City, the charismatic star has been in and around music and broadcasting for over 60 years.

Showing no signs of slowing down, today Billy hosts a morning show from 10am-1pm every Saturday and Sunday on Liverpool Live Radio — packed with great music, fun and games and special guests. Meanwhile, he's always on some sort of crazy adventure with his beloved Lesley. We caught up with Billy about his colourful career and life....



LVL: Firstly, how are you and what have you been up to recently?

BILLY: I'm fine — problems with walking and usual ups and downs. Not bad for 82! Been to a few shows at The Empire and Floral Pavilion recently — very entertaining as long as you don't buy a drink! Both theatres have a packed spring and summer. I've also been spending time sorting a mountain of music and memorabilia.



LVL: Tell us about Liverpool Live Radio and your show...

BILLY: Liverpool Live is approaching its 4th year and we have just received our 4th award. We have a very experienced team of presenters from music and chat to local interest and business. The very experienced Roy Basnett covers local happenings and local brand leaders. We have specialised music shows such as Country from legend Ethan Allan, whilst Paul Higgs has a first class sports programme.

There's the award winning Dysgraceful Show with the unique Miss Grace each Monday for all LGBTQ+ or whatever letters have been added. There's Rock with Smigger on Tuesdays and late night shows with Geoff Webster. Then there's Soul music every Wednesday with John Jessop and Frankie Connor plays Oldies every Saturday.

On Saturdays from 10am I present 3 hours of music, chat and local music and entertainment guests. I present a Unique Covers and Motown show every Sunday — playing cover versions of big hits and Motown classics — and include the world famous Hold Your Plums quiz show. Of course, we can't forget the breakfast show each weekend before me, with the big fellah Rod Keay.

Our female presenters Claudine Hope and Claire Campbell are really dynamic as presenters. From our line up from 6am with the likes of Rob Charles, Roy Basnett, John Jessop and Shaun Tilley, we're the most experienced team around. We all owe it all to the Station Manager Rod Keay for setting up the station and everything he does.

LVL: How does it compare to other radio stations?

BILLY: Unlike Radio Merseyside, we do not have the vast avenues of news and entertainment resources. None of our presenters have a producer — they arrange their own guests, features and select their own music. Our outside broadcast van is the biggest on local radio and attends many big events.

LVL: Looking back at your career, what would you say are your most memorable moments?

BILLY: So many memorable events winning many radio awards, presenting many TV shows, Hold Your Plums being the biggest selling DVD when issued and having the biggest Sunday audience in the North West. Selling 58 Pontins events out and many Empire, Floral Pavilion and Philharmonic events for the station.



Then there's playing football at Goodison and Anfield and being awarded the Citizen of Honour by the Liverpool City Council. But I think also a very finest honour was a letter from a BBC programme head congratulating me on the way I presented my programme during the Hillsborough disaster.



LVL: What interviews have stood out the most?

BILLY: Impossible to select as there are so many famous local and international show business stars I've interviewed! Some standout ones are Elton John, Paul and Ringo, Eartha Kitt, Joan Collins, Hulk Hogan, Alex Ferguson, Dave Hickson, Richard Todd, Harold Wilson, Roger Moore, Patrick McNee, Diana Ross, Lee Oswald's wife Marina, Wilson Pickett, Stevie Wonder, Slade, Status Quo.

There are have been so many local TV and music stars but my most memorable is The Lone Ranger (Clayton Moore) and Batman (Adam West). Also at one event I interviewed the original Riddler, Robin, Catwoman and The Joker, as well as The Hulk.

LVL: What's your secret to success and being so good at what you do for so long?

BILLY: I'd say knowing the area and the listeners — knowing their likes and dislikes. Meeting as many listeners as possible. Being honest in stating your opinions on air, loving your job and making sure you research your guests and subjects. Always be accessible and have friends and management around you who who believe in you.

LVL: Lesley must be a great influence right?

BILLY: Lesley is my rock — her humour, her love and affection and most of all her encouragement and belief in me. She has blossomed so much as a personality and I owe all I am to her — I'm a lucky man.


LVL: You guys are always so happy and have so much fun together — what's your advice for a happy relationship like yours?

BILLY: Laugh together, cry together, hold hands and tell each other you love each other.

Local legend Chris Munro's captivating life story reveals a fascinating insight into growing up in Liverpool slums, crime, gambling, winning it all, losing it all and survival against all odds.



Seen It All, Done It All is the story of a man who has literally done just that. Chris Munro's memoirs will make you laugh, cry and shake your head in disbelief — capturing the brutal realities of growing up in postwar Liverpool and living a dramatic life of highs, lows and everything in between.

Starting with his tales of begging, selling pigeons and crime in the slums of Vauxhall Road, Scotland Road and later Cantril Farm Estate, Seen It All, Done It All takes you on an epic journey through Chris' eventful life. From thieving and crime to borstal and jail, it's a journey of survival and self-discovery.



Chris' eventful story includes football, working as a doorman, rubbing shoulders with celebrities, travelling the U.S, becoming a millionaire only to it all, charity work, tragic loss and life-changing revelations. Oozing with thought-provoking pearls of wisdom, the auto-biography came about after Chris beat cancer for the third time.

Chris explained: "I initially had prostate cancer back in 2003 and have since had thyroid cancer twice. I've beat it every time and after the third time I decided to finally write my auto-biography. My life has been so eventful and people have always said I could write a book so I decided to finally do it. You may not believe some of the things in my story but it's all true — as crazy as some of it is."

He continued: "Growing up in the post-war slums was very brutal and I don't hold back when re-living the tales. I'm not proud of my life of crime but that said the good deeds and charity work I've done far outweighs the bad. I've gambled, built up multi-million pound empires from nothing and lost it all again — there are certainly lots of lessons to be learnt from my story."



Seen It All, Done It All will entertain, shock and inspire all at once. Labelled 'Miracle Man' by doctors, Chris Munro is a force of nature with a thousand stories that have all finally been penned — thanks to the inspiration of surviving cancer for a third time. One thing for sure is he is not slowing down any time soon.



Chris said: "A psychic once told me I'd live to 94 and at the time I thought she meant 1994! The kind of life I've lived I'm lucky to still be here but you've got to keep going and even at my age I still look to the future. I've certainly lived a full life and seen a lot in my life and I hope that the book will entertain people, whilst inspiring them and teaching them the things I've learnt."



Having raised tens of thousands of pounds for many charitable causes during his life, Chris is donating money from his book sales to the RNLI due to their bravery and also to breast cancer research — something his wife tragically died of at the age of just 37.

Chris' book was edited by prolific local writer Peter Etherington and has been published by Liverpool Books Online — an ethical publishing company ran by Susan Westoby that gives writers a fair deal and has produced Times Best Sellers such as Memoirs Of A Liverpool Stripper. In addition to Chris donating profits to charity, Liverpool Books Online are donating to Mr Old Hall Street and the Liverpool homeless.



Susan explained: "After self-publishing my book, Saxon Falcon, and winning Best Self Published Fiction with Writers News, I set out to help other writers get their stories out there too. There are so many talented writers and people with a story to tell — it's an honour to share them with the world. Chris Munro is one of them and we're excited to be releasing his profound life story, whilst donating to charity at the same time."

Seen It All Done It All / Chris Munro



With stunning grounds, a bowling green and lots of activities on site, Mariners' Park has a 360 degree approach — from independent living residents to those requiring palliative care.



The real magic is what happens on a day to day basis, however, with over 100 experienced and caring staff who go the extra mile for the residents. With high CQC, Council and carehome.co.uk ratings, the team are adored by residents and families — resulting in them being Finalists in the National British Care Awards on more than one occasion.



Director Andrew Jones said: "I'm thoroughly proud of the team here and all that they do on a daily basis to give our residents the best quality of life possible during their twilight years. You can teach people



According to researches done around the world we are facing a new epidemic — loneliness. Everywhere I looked for statistics I could see numbers concerning loneliness that sent a chill through my spine! In UK and Japan they now have Ministers Of Loneliness and that just tells me that this is a growing problem in a world that has never been so connected but at the same time so disconnected!

The Campaign To End Loneliness organization reports that over 9 million people in the UK often or always feel lonely, and around 1 in 4 people say they feel more isolated during the winter months. In a survey conducted by the BBC, over 55,000 people in the UK participated — revealing that loneliness is prevalent across all ages. The survey found that young adults aged 16-24 and adults over 75 reported feeling the loneliest.

Loneliness is not just a concept or a feeling, it has health consequences and can have a great impact on mental health and also lead to a variety of negative consequences. Research has shown that people who experience chronic loneliness are at an increased risk of developing depression, anxiety and other mental disorders, and that sleep quality appears to worsen with loneliness. Loneliness has also been associated with an increased risk of cardiovascular disease and cognitive decline, as well as depression and anxiety.



I think that we are too occupied and stressful today and we are forgetting the things that really matter in the end, and it's even funny to know that we are more isolated than ever before in spite of the world wide web. To change the situation I think that Fred Rogers was so right when he said "There are three ways to ultimate success: The first way is to be kind. The second way is to be kind. The third way is to be kind."

And I like to add, be kind and give your time to those you think might need it the most. Today we are so busy that we don't have any time to spend on our parents or elderly people in our family which is so sad because perhaps the only thing that matters in the end is what we did to make life happier for the people we love, and to show kindness to our fellow man.



So how can we change this situation?

- 1. Promote and prioritize social connections
- 2. Foster an inclusive society
- 3. Provide mental health support and resources
- 4. Promote an active and healthy lifestyle
- 5. Improve public transport and infrastructure
- Encourage volunteering and civic engagement
- 7. Increase education and awareness
- 8. Utilize technology
- 9. Support intergenerational activities
- 10. Encourage empathy and kindness

We ourselves can do so many things to make our lives a little less lonely. We can reach out to our community and join all kinds of activities where we can perhaps find new friends. We can also find an online game or a chat group we can join etc.

We can practice self-love and also stay positive and we can encourage ourselves to step out of our comfort zones and to do some charity work in our community, that might ease our loneliness in a big way. So my dear reader, what we all should bear in mind if we want to see the loneliness statistics go down is to never let anyone dine alone and we should reach out to help where ever help is needed.

Here at La Vida Liverpool magazine, we cover a wide range of things — from restaurants, pubs and bars to events, wellness and wellbeing — but some things really do require first hand knowledge in order to write with any credibility. When I was asked to cover Pellowah energy healing, the only way was to experience it myself....

Pellowah energy healing works specifically with an individual in connection with their higher consciousness to remove blockages, shift consciousness and bring about lasting positive change. It is delivered both in person and from a distance, with the vast majority of sessions being done distantly.

Whereas some may be sceptical, the practice has exploded internationally, with around 8,000 practitioners globally and over 500 in the UK & Ireland since it was introduced here in 2018 by Julie Parker.



There are also hundreds of teachers globally and 12 active teachers in the UK, who facilitate the Pellowah Level I and II workshop, which qualifies participants to deliver Pellowah sessions. One of these UK teachers is Anne Lloyd, who founded Pellowah Healing Liverpool in 2019 and has delivered the healing to many people whilst teaching 14 students how to become a practitioner.



Anne told me: "Pellowah, meaning 'a radical shift in consciousness', operates on various levels, delving into the body's meridians and the chakra system. Through this energy modality, it is possible to attain relaxation, calmness, clarity, expanded intuition and

profound change. The transformative effects extend to DNA activation, aligning our consciousness with the evolving world around us."

She continued: "Pellowah calls to us when we are ready for change. The shift in consciousness enables a profound understanding of one's self, one's place in the world and the optimal path to fulfil life's purpose. Pellowah inspires creativity and unlocks inner knowledge by connecting our minds to our higher selves — the repository of our true essence, talents, wisdom and life purpose."



After hearing about some of the profound experiences and testimonials from others, I decided to give it a go myself — how on earth could I write about this without experiencing the energy healing first hand? When I was told that it would be from a distance, with me lying on my bed at home in the dark and Anne miles away, I must admit I was as sceptical as I was intrigued.

My first Pellowah energy healing happened on a Wednesday night. Anne gave me the instructions to lie on my bed in darkness and with no distractions — I'll be honest it felt pretty weird and I was wondering what she was doing, miles away from me. I eventually drifted off to sleep and that night I had the craziest lucid dreams — about being in a room that was another dimension and wild beast like creatures. My dreams were powerful and felt like I was having outer body experiences.



The next morning I was totally wiped, despite sleeping for almost 12 hours, but the following days resulted in lots of clarity and exciting business developments happened for me. I don't know what it did to me but something powerful definitely happened! Strangely, I was feeling run down with a wheezy chest when I lay down for the treatment, but this onset of illness completely disappeared afterwards.



Fascinated by this experience, I asked Anne for another treatment — now knowing what Pellowah was. The second time was much more physical. This time with Anne working in person, as her energy work kicked in I could feel strange movements within my head and body. It was almost as if energy was moving within my forehead and stomach — bizarre sensations I'd never felt before!

Again, I drifted off towards the end of the treatment and felt pretty wiped afterwards. After more wild and vivid dreams that night and a 12 hour sleep, I went about my usual busy days and had a few business meetings the next couple of days. Whether this is anything to do with Pellowah, I am unsure, but a few people were compelled to project their life stories onto me for hours and people seemed drawn to me.

Anne told me following the experiences: "Whether I am working in person or from a distance, the Pellowah energy uses me as an instrument to achieve what is necessary to bring about the change agreed between the higher consciousness of the recipient and Pellowah. Some experience profound shifts after one session, other may be called to explore further, guided by their evolving needs and inner wisdom."




For me, there are three types of people — those who believe, those who are open to the possibilities and those who will never believe something unless they can physically see it as concrete. I am definitely one who is open to any possibility in this realm and truly believe in energy forces.

What I can say is I know what I experienced through Pellowah and things definitely happened within me. There have been big shifts and things happen for me in my life since — such as meeting my new business partner days later and going on to form a new super agency, Sound Media, that this magazine is now part of.



Pellowah Healing Liverpool provides workshops in Liverpool, Wirral, and North Wales. Workshops, for up to 10 participants, are flexible and for an immersive experience a full 3-night residential retreat is also available. Following the workshops, participants gain admission to a growing Facebook support group, fostering a community where stories are shared, questions are answered, and personal growth thrives.

Anne summarised: "Pellowah is growing in popularity and I offer treatments for £40 or two day workshops to become a practitioner. People say it's 'the best healing modality that you've never heard of' but the way it's growing it could become as well known as reiki. Everything is energy and people are becoming more open to alternative healing methods — but you need to be open to receive it of course."



An 'inspirational' survivor has taken on the running of Liverpool men's mental health hub, Inner Guru's The Hub. Chris Jervis, 34, overcame a traumatic childhood, breakdowns and self harm, and is now on a mission to help other men through a wide range of support and services at The Hub.



Based at Parkinson Road in Walton, Inner Guru's The Hub was opened by Lewis Powell in March 2022 — offering men support and courses in order to increase their mental, emotional and spiritual wellbeing, as well as having a gym, a sauna and cold water therapy. The daily running of the hub will now be taken on by Chris Jervis, who has dedicated his life to helping other men avoid crisis.



As a child, Chris grew up in drug dens
— witnessing shocking things such as
prostitution and hard drug taking — and as
a young child he had to beg to fund adults'
drug habits. He was bullied in school and
when his mother died of a drug overdose
his life spiralled out of control into adult

life — resulting in deep depression, a breakdown in a job centre, self harm and suicide attempts.



Chris eventually found solace in men's sharing circles, breathwork and getting out in nature on treks. For the past two years he has become qualified in many mental health and wellbeing practises and has become trained as a mountain guide. He created Primal Mentality and has helped many men through sharing circles, breathwork, meditation, cold water therapy and hikes.



Chris said: "I'm delighted to be managing The Hub and look forward to helping as many men as possible — bridging the gap and preventing them from getting to the stage I did. The men's mental health crisis is very real — just over three out of four suicides (76%) are by men and suicide is the biggest cause of death for men under 35. Men are suffering out there and so many don't know where to turn."

He continued: "I was lucky because I found a community of men in Liverpool through The Hub. I'm still healing but have set out on a mission to help as many men as possible and we'll be offering a drop in centre, fitness sessions, cold water therapy, sauna therapy, breathwork, sharing circles, hikes and more. We're looking to create a safe space and a community in which men can heal their traumas."

Under Chris' management, The Hub will offer a free drop in centre with coffee, support and signposting to professional help if required. Wellness Wednesdays at 7pm will offer circuit training, cold water therapy and sauna, meanwhile there'll be Primal Mentality on Thursdays with breathwork, meditation and sharing circles. Meanwhile, there'll be regular community hikes, days out in nature and retreats.



The Hub's Founder Lewis Powell said: "It's great to have Chris running The Hub — he's an inspirational man and if there's anyone who understands men's mental health it's him. Unfortunately, due to the pressures of today's society the crisis is worsening and suicides are on the rise. NHS mental health waiting lists are over 12 months long and this is why places like ours are vital to bridge the gap."

Both Inner Guru's The Hub and Chris' Primal Mentality are CICs however funding isn't easy to come by, with many organisations challenging for limited pots. The team have set up a Just Giving page to raise money to provide free support and therapy to Merseyside men that will in turn ensure that the centre is sustainable and covers its running costs. Team Member Rob Collier, also a suicide survivor, said: "We have a very special hub here and we've helped many men these past two years, but as the mental health crisis is getting worse we need to step up even more. We need funds to help as many men free of charge as possible and to keep the place running and we need to make ourselves known as a place where men can come for support in a non clinical environment."



The team at The Hub are calling out to any men seeking support to get in touch — the first step of healing is to reach out and Chris Jervis is a fine example of that. It is also calling upon members of the public to pledge a donation to their cause or if there are any groups or practitioners who would like to hire their space for a reasonable cost, that too would help.







A mother from South Liverpool has won 'The Secret Weapon Serum Scandal' after years of fighting, but could lose over £300,000 despite winning a huge court case twice, one in the Lower Court and the other in the High Court of Appeal.

Georgina Tang, 60, is the owner of multiaward winning natural organic skincare brand, Yours Naturally Naturally Yours. She recently won a ground-breaking case against Kate McIver Skin Limited but stands to claim back just a fraction of the amount spent fighting to reclaim her invention that Kate McIver Skin falsely claimed to create.



Despite succeeding in the claim of 'Reverse Passing Off' and Copyright Infringement after five long years of legal battle, the legal costs have put a huge strain on Ms Tang's business and her family. After spending around £310,000 on legal costs so far, including a recent appeal from the Defence that almost plunged her into financial ruin, she has been awarded just £48,000 by court for the appeal application having spent around £96,000 on that.



Georgina is a well known pioneer of results-driven skincare and haircare products within the beauty industry. She has created many 'miracle' formulas that have had profound results on people through her multi-award winning brand. One of these products was her 'Elixir' antiaging serum that was used by the late Kate McIver when she was having chemotherapy in 2017.

Georgina created Elixir aka 'Miracle In A Bottle' in 2015 after having great success with other "skin-kind" products for her son Alessio when he had chemotherapy. One night when she kissed him goodnight, she found lumps of hair on his pillow — breaking down and crying, she was absolutely determined to make haircare products to aid hair growth and Alessio now has a full head of hair.

In 2015, at 52, Georgina wanted to create an antiaging formula for her own skin as she couldn't find one that was effective on the market. Due to the profound success of her new Elixir, she supplied to beauticians and retailers including Kate McIver — who became a 'white label' client.



White label arrangement began in 2018, with Ms. McIver using Georgina's product name "Elixir" and later changing it to Secret Weapon. Completely unbeknown to Ms Tang, Ms McIver started to misrepresent

that she created Elixir aka Secret Weapon whilst she had chemotherapy — even stating that she made it in her own back room with her very own hands.

Kathryn Orr, then Marketing Director of Kate McIver Skin, terminated their working arrangement with immediate effect on November 30th 2018 — launching Secret Weapon Limited Edition based on Elixir the very next day. Kate McIver's 'Secret Weapon' shot to fame with the fake story and was championed by influencers and celebrities such as Lisa Snowdon, Danielle Llyod, Trinny Woodall and Alex Gerrard.



Kate McIver engaged Pelham to produce two serums based on Elixir. On this, Judge Hacon wrote: "The message presented by KMS in respect of both REFORMULATIONS was that it was the same serum as had been sold as the Elixir serum. In my view, Ms McIver and KMS remained very attached to the attractive story of Ms McIver's having created their serum because of her efforts to recover from the effects of chemo."

He went on to say: "They continued to state that this was the serum they were selling. This is supported by Kathryn Orr's interview for the Ladies Of Liverpool podcast, the prominent use of ORIGINAL on the packaging and the repeated use of the Danielle Lloyd photos to promote the product."



On 20th April 2023, Judge Hacon in the Intellectual Property Enterprise Court in Manchester declared the case victorious in the favour of Ms Tang. The case has since been dubbed 'The Secret Weapon Serum Scandal' and has been subject to various coverage in the press, however the appeal from the defence extended the case further and left Ms Tang on the verge of financial ruin.

Judge Hacon wrote: "But while her story of being driven to create a serum to cure her bad skin was presumably attractive from a MARKETING point of view, IT WAS NOT TRUE. The implied published statement as I have found it to be, that Ms Tang did not create the Elixir serum, WAS FALSE. On the evidence available I have no doubt that Ms McIver KNEW that her statement WAS FALSE. Malice is established."

Currently over £300,000 down despite winning, it is particularly damaging to Ms Tang. She founded her company due to her son Alessio, who has severe complex needs such as Autism, Attention Deficit Disorder, learning difficulties and communication difficulties to name just a few. She had hoped her business would leave a nest egg for him when she's gone, but that now remains in jeopardy.

Ms Tang said: "This long legal battle has taken its toll not just on my mental health but also on my family's financial stability. I've had to cash in my pensions, we've sold my husband's car, we've had to live without heating despite my son Alessio being immune compromised so he feels the cold more than the average person." "We've had to eat expired food for free from Zero Waste Liverpool by queuing out in the cold for hours. I have to offer water to Alessio instead milk and cut down on his food, especially fruits which he loves. He needs a healthy balanced diet due to his complex medical health conditions."

"It has been so tough that I've found myself in tears, as well as wanting to end my life on occasions, especially during October and November 2023 where I had to find... £50,000 for legal representation fees. I got so depressed, especially after the rejection from my bank for a re-mortgage loan."

"I felt so hopeless and couldn't see a way out until I got an online personal loan approved. Then the lump sum of my occupational pension came through, however this money was planned to pay off part of the house mortgage. I now have £65,000 of loans to repay. Such stressful times as I worried sick about my business would collapse without money but most of all, losing our home! I feel utterly guilty for putting my family in this impossible situation."

Georgina continued: "I actually won 4 legal battles against KMS, so far I received £8000 from KMS for winning the debarring application. Also I have been awarded £48,000 for the appeal and around £5000 – £7000 for the security costs application but KMS failed to pay on the deadline set by court, therefore my legal team has commenced a winding up petition against them."



"But that's not all. I need to find money to fight again to recover the £210,000 spent on winning the Lower court application, however I don't know how much I can recover if any from KMS. Therefore I could be down by over £300,000 and my family has suffered terribly so that I reclaim my invention back from Kate McIver."

This is a legal history breaking case on "Reverse Passing Off" being the first ever case won by a trial, setting the foundation for future cases. Even more ground breaking is that it won not once but twice by trial! Georgina has demonstrated the strength and resilience of a warrior, despite fighting an uphill legal battle with her legal team.

Her Lawyer, Kate Irvine-Yates, said: "I am unbelievably happy for you. You have shown such resilience and strength of character throughout the claim and the appeal. I stand in awe of all my litigation clients who engage in claims because it is a time of real stress and very high stakes. You have endured not only a claim but the appeal too and you deserve to have your strength recognised. You have been a force to be reckoned with and I am delighted that you have triumphed."

Throughout the process, Ms Tang had offered mediations in order to agree on an out of court settlement but these offers were rejected by Kate McIver Skin. Instead, the legal battle was dragged on for years — leading Ms Tang on the verge of financial ruin.

Ms Tang explained: "Why would anyone do something like this to an honest person like me? I am now having to fight them over court costs and compensation as I cannot be out of pocket like this. Honestly, I will be very lucky to walk away without a huge loss — where is the justice in that?"

Junior players of all ages are wanted at Wallasey Rugby Club, in response to the decline in rugby participation in England. With rugby participation down by 67% and child mental health and obesity major issues, the club is calling for kids to get off their computers and onto the pitch in a big recruitment drive.



The Wirral club have sessions for all ages every Sunday from 10am that consist of a warm up, training, a match and food and drink afterwards. There's a big emphasis on inclusivity, teamwork, positive mental health, discipline and respect — teaching children important life lessons — whilst the rugby is taken place in a controlled, regulated and safe environment.



Children can join for just £8 per month, with £5 per additional child, and family memberships start from just £10 per month — giving parents access to club events, venue hire and hospitality discounts. The club has a great sense of community and junior players enjoy it so much that no child has left since joining — such is the sense of belonging and togetherness.

Together with local clubs such as Prenton RUFC and Oldershaw, Wallasey Rugby Club is leading the way in the drive to increase junior rugby participation. Their aim is to tackle the child mental and physical health crisis through rugby with the key message to parents being that safety is paramount at all times.



Wallasey Rugby Club's Youth Coach, Tom O'Donnell, said: "There's a worry amongst parents that rugby is dangerous but our youth rugby is controlled and regulated — with tag rugby up to a certain age. I'd say junior rugby is safer that football in many respects and it's less toxic — with a bigger emphasis on discipline, respect and fair play."

He continued: "We welcome children of all abilities and backgrounds — we've had many additional needs children train and play with us and there's a great sense of camaraderie. It's an opportunity for children to get off their devices, get fit and become part of a community — we teach them qualities that will set them up for life, whilst they get to meet new friends."



Although it has been debated in the media whether rugby is dangerous for kids, experts believe it's the best discipline parents can offer to a child or teachers can offer to students. Parents of Wallasey Rugby Club's junior players have reported great improvements to their children's mental, emotional and physical wellbeing since joining the club.



One parent said: "I can honestly say Harrison's confidence has improved massively. He couldn't walk until he was about 4 years old so has always been reluctant to join in with sports but always wanted to — this has helped massively!"

Another said: "Since Frankie left playing football and decided he wanted to learn rugby his confidence has grown and I've never seen someone so happy to get out on the field with all the lads, most of which are bigger than him, and just get stuck in. They have all connected so well and are a big group of pals."



Wallasey Rugby Club have begun their recruitment drive for the new season, starting in September 2024, and are offering parents the chance to bring their child or children along for a free trial. Children will be able to get a feel for the game and the club — in a warm, welcoming and inclusive environment.

Tom O'Donnell summarised: "It's time to combat the very real issues of child mental health problems, obesity and disorder and there's no better way to do so than through rugby. The sport helps them develop as young people and the whole family can become part of something bigger here at the club."


