

A meal prep guru from Liverpool has just completed his 1,500th consecutive day of running — covering almost 19,000 miles in over four years of daily runs. Andrew Kelly, 27, is the Co-Founder of meal prep company Benno Box and attributes his superhuman fitness to his healthy diet and discipline.



Averaging 12.6 miles per day over four years (just under a half marathon each day), Andrew is a machine when it comes to long distance running. Having competed in some of the biggest races in the world, including 200-250 mile events in Florida and Arizona, Liverpool's very own Roger Bannister is showing no signs of slowing down.



Andrew's story started in 2019 when he started running 2 miles each day. He soon became obsessed and decided to start making his own healthy, high protein and low sugar meals to help him reach peak condition. As his obsession with running grew, on New Year's Eve 2019 he completely quit drinking alcohol, and as his stamina improved people started asking about his diet more.



In 2020 during lockdown, Andrew started supplying family and friends with his meal prep meals — becoming so popular that he decided to quit his job and set up Benno Box. Fast forward four years, Andrew has now ran for 1,500 days straight and Benno Box has supplied over 1,700 customers with over 100,000 healthy meals.

Andrew explained: "I started running just a couple of miles a day but became addicted to how it made me feel. I started testing myself and realised that to get to the next level I needed to cut out alcohol and have a healthy diet. I initially trained as a KP whilst at college so drew on that knowledge from the chefs to create nutritious, protein rich and super tasty meals — it was my diet that helped me get to the next level."

He continued: "During lockdown, after supplying friends and family with my meals, they spread like wildfire by word of mouth. I quit my job as an engineer and founded Benno Box with my friend. Four year later, we have a unit just outside the city centre and a great team — helping change lives one healthy meal at a time — and I've completed some of the most challenging races in the world."



Just as Andrew's running has gone from strength to strength, as has Benno Box. With delicious meals such as Salt & Pepper Chicken Noodles, Tex Mex Bowl and Korean Beef and delivery across Merseyside, Benno Box has become a big hit amongst those wanting a healthy diet and professionals who don't have time to cook.



Benno Box offers a huge menu for custom orders or set meal plans such as 5 meals per week for as little as £39.99 delivered. Customer feedback has been profound — with countless reviews from people who have lost weight, overcome eating disorders and lived healthier lives. Like Andrew, many sport enthusiasts and athletes have attributed the Benno Box diet to taking their fitness to the next level.

With lots of variety, Benno Box offers a sustainable and 360 degree approach to diet — with lots of snacks, treats and drinks to complement the healthy meals. Teaching is regarded as a challenging role with long hours and lots of paperwork, so the thought of someone moving on to work up to 15 hours a day in their own bakery may seem absurd. Meet Mike Kerr who quit his job as a teacher to open Born To Bake — a career change that's paid off big time!



Born To Bake is based in Bromborough, Wirral, and supplies top quality breads, sausage rolls, pasties, pies and cakes, primarily to businesses. Founded in October 2020 during lockdown, it was a huge gamble for Mike, but four years down the line they're supplying to the likes of Liverpool FC, The Royal Liverpool Golf Club, The Titanic Hotel and The Orient Express.



Born To Bake is all about top quality produce with no additives or preservatives, baked fresh on site daily, and they offer free next day delivery to businesses. Whilst Born To Bake has now established itself as one of the region's premier bakeries, Mike was labelled crazy by some when he decided to enter the world of baking.



Diagnosed with Autism, Mike is a perfectionist and workaholic. Back in 2016 he had set up Piadina Pronto, an Italian street food business he ran alongside teaching, and sought the help of baker Lee Hollywood (brother of the famous Paul Hollywood), to perfect his dough. He soon became obsessed with baking and the rest, as they say, is history.



Mike explained: "I've always been an entrepreneur from an early age — from selling sweets as a 5-year old to convincing my Dad to start a kebab business aged 10, after a visit to London. I actually became a Computer Operations Analyst for a top international company before moving into teaching I.T. and Computing (Secondary, Further Education, Primary levels) and additional needs teaching."

He continued: "I'm always on the lookout for opportunities and varying circumstances prevented me from being involved in McDonalds in the UK, Pandora and the development of sat nav. During a visit to Italy in 2016 I discovered Piadina and saw the potential of Italian flatbread becoming as popular as pizza, so I decided to launch Piadina Pronto and this in turn led me to the art of baking."



Piadina Pronto has become a successful business in its own right, with a trailer serving at events and festivals, but after seeking dough baking advice from the Hollywoods, Mike became obsessed with perfecting baking. In 2020, after endless hours of baking various breads, he decided to quit teaching and open Born To Bake — with the aim of supplying Piadina Pronto and other hospitality businesses.



Mike said: "People thought I was crazy at first, entering into something that I knew nothing about, during uncertain times with Covid, but I have Autism and one of my traits is being an obsessive perfectionist. When I get an idea about something I go for it! I assembled a great team and at first it was slow but as our reputation grew, the big contracts soon came in. Today we are thriving!"







1. No Food Safety Management System

Katy: "The premises may not be dirty but there is no documented evidence that food safety is being taken seriously. Remember, if it's not written down, there's no proof. That's why I've written an easy to follow food safety system. If the paperwork is too complicated and cumbersome then staff find it too hard to follow. 2. Failure To Manage An Existing Food Safety System

In some circumstances I would wear gloves, i.e. handling fish, peeling garlic or onions but that's about it."

Katy: "Food businesses by law should have adequate lighting, ventilation, drainage and

a dependable supply of hot and cold potable water, with separate sinks for hand washing and food preparation. Poorly laid out or difficult to access areas, such as behind ovens and freezers, may result in staff failing to clean effectively, which can result in a build-up of dangerous levels of bacteria and an infestation of pests. Some staff blame the kitchen by saying it's old. You can still keep an old kitchen clean so there is no excuse."





District House, located at 112 Victoria Road, is a creative hub where you'll find quality coffee, food, drink, art, music and more.



House is the latest addition to the vibrant Victoria Quarter — a light, spacious and informal hangout that features leftfield pop art for sale on its walls. I ended up working in Liverpool, got involved in the music scene and the rest is history."



A rebel with an attitude, Jayne quickly became heavily involved in Liverpool's counter culture music scene — fronting Big In Japan alongside the like of Holly Johnson and Ian Broudie and also fronting Pink Industry. An integral figure of the iconic Eric's, she went on to become a driving force behind Cream and a pioneering voice of creatives in the city — founding The Baltic Triangle and Liverpool Biennial amongst many other achievements.

Jayne explained: "It's been quite a journey, when I look back. Eric and I still have District in The Baltic Triangle, an inclusive space for diverse music and club nights, but it feels really special to open a venue in New Brighton — where it all began for me. New Brighton was such a great place to run away to as a teen and it represented an escape from my troubled childhood, I now want to give back to the town that gave to me some 50 years ago."



Jayne is drawing on all her creative contacts and bringing some incredible music, art and culture to District House — with lots of exciting announcements and pop up events to come. Coupled with artisan food and drink, a great atmosphere — oh and not to mention the secret garden to the rear — it seems New Brighton has a new gem.

Jayne summarised: "It's great to be part of this movement here in New Brighton — it reminds me of The Baltic Triangle movement when we took back the buildings from the big banks and corporations and made it an independently owned creative district. I admire what Dan Davies has done here in The Victoria Quarter — it's a triumph for creativity and we're thrilled to be involved."







A Liverpool charity single is aiming to be Christmas No.1 this year. Always A Home (At Christmas) is the collaborative effort of music project, Primal Live, and features 18 artists who competed in the latest song contest at Camp & Furnace. Like the song contests, the single is raising money for The Whitechapel Centre's work helping the homeless.



Consisting of 3 acoustic guitarists, 2 electric guitarists, a pianist, a drummer, a violinist, a rapper and 18 singers, Always A Home (At Christmas) is a powerful song about homelessness and kindness at Christmas. The single is shortlisted in the official UK charts alongside the likes of Sam Fender and Linkin Park and has been featured by NME magazine.



The dynamic track is the latest evolution from the ground-breaking music project launched earlier this year. Primal Live provides music artists with a 7 week development programme before giving them a platform to compete in a huge song contest at Camp & Furnace that raises money for the Whitechapel Centre — with over £8,000 raised to help the homeless so far.



The project has now partnered with the international music college, the SAE Institute, thanks to the Liverpool college's Senior Music Business Lecturer, Duncan Lewis, and winners of the song contest receive studio recording time. Primal Live not only provides artists with support and guidance from industry experts, it offers them a platform and a chance to take their music to the next level.

Primal Live Founder Andy Sampson said: "It's been an amazing journey so far this year and the concept has exploded beyond our dreams — we're overwhelmed with the amount of applications from artists and there's such incredible talent coming through. Each artist is unique and many have overcome their own adversities and it's a pleasure to help them develop whilst raising money for an important cause."





They were standoffish at first, but the barriers are breaking down, and today I was getting offered food and stuff. The couple who's flat I was in were pretty cool, they liked me because I fixed their cooker for them. I was chatting to the guy, who drives for Uber-eats of an evening, he was telling me about Bulgaria; the monetary and political situation, and encouraging me to travel there. He said he'd point me in the right direction if I wanted to go, I thought it might be a nice quest to go on next year.

When I was leaving, I said to them "Ok Mum and Dad, I have to leave home now and find my own place, I'm going to miss youse, thanks for looking after me" they both started laughing with me, but we all knew I had been a little bit adopted for the day.

They didn't laugh in Bulgarian, I guess laughter is a universal language. (God that's a good line, I'm getting good at this writing thing!).

As I was loading my tools into the van, all happy to have spent the day with my adopted Bulgarian Mum and Dad, I made eye contact with a Rasta guy who was bouncing down the street with a bit of funky stride on, we smiled at each other. "Elllo King!!" He bellowed at me, then he beat his heart two times with his inside of his closed fist and exclaimed "RespectA!" to me, in a deep stentorian voice. And I thought 'what a great hiya that was!' He bounced on.

On the way home I stopped at the View, up at Everton Park. It was golden hour. On one side of me I could see the sun setting over the city, and on the other there was a massive visible full moon. I was watching the city, thinking how Liverpool is like a parent to us too. It looks after you, it's proud, it wants you to do well. This City adopts, it always has, and it's always been better off for it. I'm a child of this City, we all are, and it doesn't matter what colour you are, or who you pray to, or where you come from. Scousers only really have one true prejudice....

We just fucking hate dickheads!



WIn this La Vida Liverpool exclusive, we talk to Wirral Mayor Cherry Povall to learn more about her and her role as Mayor. A trailblazing female Mayor, Cherry is forward-thinking, committed to promoting Wirral and works hard to help people, businesses and good causes. Here's what she has to say....



LA VIDA: So Cherry, please could you tell us about yourself and your life before becoming Mayor Of Wirral?

MAYOR POVALL: I have had a career where I have worn lots of different hats. I came to Liverpool to Teachers Training College and taught in several schools in Liverpool and Cheshire. My Husband came out of the Army and we bought our first Newsagents shop and I gave up teaching. We went on to own and run five shops and a Post Office. During this time I was appointed as a Magistrate and served 33 years on the Bench.

During this period I also returned to University and obtained an Honours Degree in Law. I worked briefly as a solicitor but life intervened and my husband died. I carried on running the business with my daughter. I became a Councillor and have been one of the Councillors For Clatterbridge Ward for 17 years.



LA VIDA: How and why did you become Mayor? Can anyone become Mayor and could even I apply one day?

MAYOR POVALL: Because I have served as a Councillor for 17 years I was elected by the Council to become Mayor. You have to be an elected Councillor in order to become Mayor, so you have some work to do first Justin!



LA VIDA: What is the role of Mayor Of Wirral exactly? What is the job description and what powers do you have?

MAYOR POVALL: The Mayor is considered as the first citizen of the Wirral and Armed Forces Champion, I also carry out the Citizenship Ceremonies once a month welcoming new residents to Wirral and my job is also to represent the people of Wirral at official functions and tell the rest of the world what a great place Wirral is to live and work in. I'm trying also during my year of office to promote Wirral as a tourist destination. My job is also to Chair the Council Meetings and receive any visiting dignitaries.



LA VIDA: What is a typical day like in your role?

MAYOR POVALL: In addition to the above, I am also incredibly busy visiting all kinds of projects, schools nursing homes etc and I have in fact carried 228 engagements since I became Mayor on 15th May 2024. The ability to eat enormous amounts of cake and drink copious amounts of wine also seems to be one of the main qualifications to be Mayor! I have engagements almost every day seven days a week and up to five engagements per day but three generally is the average number.



LA VIDA: What are your main objectives and what would you like to achieve during your term?

MAYOR POVALL: I am very concerned with boosting the Tourist Economy in Wirral so that all our businesses benefit from the fabulous offer we have in Wirral — whether it's our heritage, our coastline, our parks or our fabulous countryside or golf courses. We have so much to offer that Wirral has become a best kept secret and we need to find a way to tell the rest of the world that we are the place to visit.



LA VIDA: Tell us a bit about your charity initiatives and events

MAYOR POVALL: My chosen Charities this year are IncuBabies and the Blind Sailing School and hopefully lots of the other small charities on Wirral that do not get the recognition they deserve. I am particularly keen to support charities without paid staff run purely by volunteers.

IncuBabies is about our local hospital Neo-Natal Unit helping achieve a complete refurbishment bringing it into the 21st century. The staff do incredible things there saving the lives of tiny pre-term babies and to give them modern facilities will just enhance the work they already do.

The Blind Sailing School is based on the river at the Tranmere Sailing Club. The volunteers do an amazing job giving Visually Impaired people the experience of sailing in the river but also taking them once per year to Windermere and to the Menai Straits. Their charity is helping combat social isolation and providing undreamed of experiences.

LA VIDA: And of course, your best friend and Mayoress Sheila Clarke MBE does great work too doesn't she?

MAYOR POVALL: Sheila is amazing! In June 2004 she was elected as Councillor for the Bebington ward, which she served for eight years. During her time as a Councillor, she specialised in Children Services, which included Wirral's Adoption Panel, schools, youth provision, children centres, special education needs, and all aspects of children's social care.

Sheila is also a longstanding Independent Member of Wirral's Fostering Panel with over 20 years' experience and retains a keen interest in education, in particular early years development. She is a trustee of two charities. One of these is IncuBabies, which she co-founded as a result of the care that her daughter and grandson received and is very close to her heart.

She is a member of Bebington Soroptimists and a member of the management committee of her Church Community Centre. In 1992 she was awarded an MBE for Community and Political Service.



LA VIDA: Finally, a message to the people of Wirral?

MAYOR POVALL: I feel that if during my year in office if I have been able to promote Wirral by telling anyone who will listen what a fabulous place we live in, and also been able to promote the value and rewards of volunteering, I will have achieved something. This is everyone's job too — we live in such a beautiful place, we just need to shout about it and get people to visit, and not just for big events such as the golf.



Meanwhile, she offers ethical property management and lettings with low management fees.



Based in Heswall and with a new office in West Kirby, Shirleyann is the epitome of a successful businesswoman however she has had to work very hard to get there. Growing up in Huyton and experiencing poverty and bullying, as a child she had to study hard — eventually achieving a post graduation degree in pharmacology and landing a high flying job in the industry.

After years of hard work and saving, Shirleyann got into property investment — offering people fair amounts for their properties and refurbishing them to a very high standard before selling them or renting them out. Within 4 years she had 17 properties in her portfolio and founded Home Property Solutions — specialising in ethical property investment and helping others invest in the same way.



Shirleyann explained: "Life growing up was tough. In school I was nicknamed 'pizza face' due to my acne and was also bullied because of my mullet. My parents divorced when I was a baby and I was raised by a single mum in poverty — my brothers were in and out of jail with addictions whilst I got arrested at 13 and was clubbing by the time I was 14. I knew I had to change."

She continued: "I joined an after school club and started studying really hard — it became quite addictive. I aced my GCSEs and was selected by the Prince's Trust to go round the country telling my success story to head teachers. I gained a 2.1 Degree in Illustration at Portsmouth University and a Post Grad Diploma in Pharmacology and Clinical Research — I landed a high paid role and soon discovered property investment."

Whilst her friends were partying, as a young woman Shirleyann was painting walls and refurbishing houses. She met her partner, got married and had two children, although had to re-invent herself again after challenges raising neurodivergent children took a toll on the relationship, leading to divorce. This didn't hinder Shirleyann's drive though — in fact, she became even more successful.



Shirleyann explained: "My upbringing instilled a strong work ethic into me and made me realise I can overcome any hurdle put in front of me. Home Property Solutions has become my passion and I'm proud to offer ethical property investment — giving vendors the value they deserve, keeping tenants in their homes and showing others how to invest. I have a great team around me and life is good."



Today, Shirleyann's ethical property business is thriving and she is using her story and journey as a vehicle to help and inspire others. and ethical property investors, whilst Inspiring Women Wirral is an amazing group of women and is going from strength to strength."



She continued: "Big things are coming from Inspiring Minds CIC too, with a book in the pipeline about raising children with neurodiversity. It's written by parents for parents and will be full of invaluable advice through lived experience. I've recently been diagnosed with ADHD myself which explains a lot in hindsight. Ultimately, I want to show people that through hard work your circumstances don't have to define you."

In this regular La Vida Liverpool feature, guest writer and historian David Hearn educates us on some fascinating local history. With a wealth of knowledge, David gives talks and walking tours on subjects such as the history of Liverpool, wars, slavery, maritime, Liverpool's links with America and more. In this feature he talks us through the lovely Liver Birds of Liverpool....



There are many images that make Liverpool famous around the world but, surely, one of the most iconic must be the Liver Birds perched high on the Liver Building. The female Liver Bird looks out to sea anxiously awaiting the return of their loved ones from their adventures around the world while the male Liver Bird, far more practical, looks across the city to see if the pubs are open. These Liver Birds have stood over Liverpool since 1911 and were designed by German designer Carl Bartels.



You may think that at 5.5 meters the Pier Head Liver Birds are the biggest in Liverpool but that honour goes to a much more recent sculpture. The Meccano Liver Bird, designed by Merseyside sculptor and artist Emma Rodgers, is 11 meters high and honours not only the history of Liverpool but also the memory of one of its famous sons, Frank Hornby who invented the world famous construction toy.



Outside the Town Hall at first or even second look you are hard pressed to find a Liver Bird but there is one. If look very closely you will find one very small Liver Bird. Looking at the building from the front look to the left face and you will see a door that leads to an arched metal frame in the railings surrounding the building. On the top of the arch is a lamp and on top of that lamp is a very tiny Liver Bird.



Surely everyone around the world who is interested in football will be familiar with the Liver Bird on the crest of Liverpool Football Club but if you visit Goodison Park on the outside of one of the stands is a banner reminding everyone of Everton's first League Title in 1891 and on that banner is a medal from that year showing a Liver Bird surrounded by a laurel wreath of victory. Both our great teams reinforce the importance of the Liver Bird to the city.



How many of you have noticed the Liver Birds on the Mersey Tunnel ventilation building at George's Dock on The Strand? I'm fairly sure that you will all have seen them but you would be entirely forgiven for not recognising them as Liver Birds.

High on all four sides on the ventilation tower itself you will find two Liver Birds. But they are so high up you need better eyes than I have or a camera with a long lens. The Liver Birds are seen from the front rather than for the side as they are usually portrayed. Their wings are raised on both sides and their head, complete with a crest, are between their wings.



Over the doorways on the wonderful Herbert Rowse designed building on The Strand you will also find Liver Birds but, again, they are not immediately recognisable. If you look closely however you can see the pointed beak, eyes and outstretched wings of a Liver Bird which is flying straight towards you.



Above the arched window on the right hand corner of Compton House (the former home of Marks & Spencer) you will find a modern bas-relief of two Liver Birds flanking a friend of theirs, an American bald eagle. Compton House was at one time the Compton Hotel and the building still has the British royal arms on one corner and the arms of America on the other but Liverpool has many, historical and cultural links with America so it is entirely appropriate that Liver Birds are portrayed with an American eagle.



If you have used Central Station during the last 10 years I'm sure that you could not have missed seeing this Liver Bird even though it has moved around the shopping area outside the station a few times. The Liver Bird which is called "The Spirit of Liverpool" and was conceived by Liver Bird Inc., funded by the Liverpool Commercial District Partnership and is in memory of the late Paul Rice, the partnership's former chief executive. The sculptor was Rick Myers.



Not all Liver Birds are old. It is, perhaps, not surprising that Liver Birds are used in advertising in and around Liverpool. One obvious place that you would expect to find a Liver Bird doing some advertising is the coffee shop at the Royal Liver Building where they will even put a chocolate Liver Bird on your Cappuccino! Liverpool City Sights bus tour has a very up to date Liver Bird on its buses – the Liver Bird is concentrating on the commentary which it is listening to on headphones.



Liver Launderettes are the largest operators of launderettes in the UK and they have used a Liver Bird as their logo since the 1960s. St George's Hall has dozens of Liver Birds but one that needs to be seen is this wonderful gold Liver Bird on the inside of the doors to the main hall. The Liver Bird is coming towards us and has its wings stretched out.



Liverpool does not have a monopoly of Liver Birds. These examples can be found on the Wirral: Hoylake Sailing Club on the promenade in Hoylake boasts these two great examples. The dappled sunlight on the sign of the Royal Mersey Yacht Club in Rock Ferry. Home of the Open Golf championship on a number of occasions, the Royal Liverpool Golf Club can be found on Meols Drive between Hoylake and West Kirby.



Finally, I have a favourite Liver Bird. Dating from 1831 it is an early depiction of a Liver Bird and it is only tiny, stained and broken but that is not surprising when considering what it went through some 80 plus years ago. This Liver Bird is in St Luke's Church at the top of Bold Street. St Luke's was reduced to a shell in the May Blitz of 1941 but this Liver Bird survived.



There is a Liverpool saying that if the Liver Birds ever leave then Liverpool will fall. May 1941 was perhaps Liverpool's darkest hour and St Luke's symbolises how close the city came to falling but it didn't and this tiny Liver Bird is a symbol of how Liverpool survived everything that was thrown at it.



A horror car crash survivor from Wirral has achieved his dream of opening an aquatic shop after spending 6 years in a wheelchair thinking he'd never walk again. Stephen Halsey, 38, has opened Wirral Aquatics in Moreton and says business is booming since pursuing his childhood dream.



Based on Upton Road near Moreton Cross, Wirral Aquatics opened in September 2024 and features over 100 tanks of tropical fish for sale — with the aim of supporting UK breeders and giving them a platform. What started out as a hobby for Stephen has turned into a fully fledged business and his new shop has already developed a fantastic reputation amongst tropical fish enthusiasts.



Until now, the idea of Wirral Aquatics was purely a pipe dream for the father of two, following a horror car crash in 2016. The shocking crash caused him to lose sensation from his left hip down, with severe PTSD, and he was unsure if he'd ever walk again—what followed this was a miraculous oddsdefying journey of grit and determination.



It took a while for Stephen to adapt to his new restrictive way of life but sought help from his wife, a trained physio, and his mother-in-law, an occupational therapist. Determined to walk again, he attempted to build back the muscle mass through exercises and a 'hop and drag' technique to re-train his muscle memory. After 7 years of sustained effort, he was finally able to walk again.



Stephen said: "My love of fish started at an early age, as my father used to take me to different fish shops on Saturdays. I always had a tank growing up. Fish have always had a calming effect on me and have improved my mental health. This proved critical during my rehabilitation process following the crash which hugely helped with my PTSD and depression."

He continued: "After being told I'd probably never walk again, I made it my mission to prove the doctors wrong. My wife, her mother, friends, family and the NHS were all amazing and despite the PTSD and night terrors, I exercised every day and learnt to play wheelchair rugby — managing to play Internationally for Wales in the 2021 World Cup. I turned to my passion for tropical fish and during lockdown I amassed 100 tanks in our home based fish room. That project kept me going and got me through it all."



Since taking his first proper steps again in January 2023, Stephen has developed a new appreciation for life — doing 'firsts' with his family such as walking in places he only ever visited in his wheelchair. It was this new-found lust for life that prompted Stephen to pursue his childhood dream of opening his own tropical fish shop — turning his hobby at home into a business that's become more successful than he ever imagined.



Stephen explained: "Having your life turned upside down and being told you'll probably never walk again, then finally defying the odds after 7 years of persistence and sustained effort — it does something to you. I've always worked in care and have loved my job doing that but after gaining my life back I realised you only live once and decided to take the leap of faith by opening the shop."

He continued: "Opening Wirral Aquatics is a dream come true and the first couple of months have been overwhelmingly successful. We have a revolving range of beautiful fish and people have been travelling from far and wide as word

has spread about us. We work ethically, supporting UK breeders who are also ethical. Every day is a gift and I'm so grateful for the support of our customers and the Moreton community."



Wirral Aquatics is based at 20 Upton Road, Moreton, and is open 6 days a week (closed Mondays) — stocking a revolving range of tropical fish, tanks, accessories and food. When visiting, be sure to say hello to Kevin the Mbu Puffer fish — Stephen's best friend and the largest type of freshwater puffer fish of his kind, hailing from the rivers of Africa!






A woman from Wirral is improving children's mental health through fun, interactive workshops geared around positive mental health and wellbeing. Jessica Trigg, 34, launched Positivity Club CIC in 2020 during lockdown and has since helped improve the lives of around 2,000 children through her vital work.



Committed to combatting the child mental health crisis, Jess gives children the tools required to lead happy lives. Through sessions and workshops in primary schools and after school clubs, Jess teaches children about subjects such as feelings, love and self-love, kindness, anger, worry and gratitude — delivered through fun and engaging games.



With incredible feedback from teachers, parents and children, Jess' work bridges the gap at a time when it's truly needed. According to a recent study, one in six children aged five to 16 were identified as having a probable mental health problem and just over one in three children and young people with a diagnosable mental health condition get access to NHS care and treatment.



Furthermore, according to Children's Society 50% of all mental health problems start by the age of 14 and according to Children's Society 39.2% of 6 to 16 year olds had experienced deterioration in mental health since 2017. These alarming stats make Jess even more determined to deliver her workshops and reach out to as many children as possible.



Jess explained: "I started Positivity Club CIC because I have lived with anxiety and depression from childhood and I wanted children to understand that they are not

alone. From working with a broad range of children for over 16 years, across early years to teenagers and even teaching in Thailand and volunteering in Australia, I have developed an understanding of how to make mental health fun."

She continued: "I believe by creating engaging activities around serious topics inspires learning and instils coping strategies. When the children learn that I struggled too, it creates a special bond on understanding and like-mindedness."



Profound feedback for Positivity Club CIC has been flying in — with many parents and teachers stating that they've noticed some really positive changes in children. With one-third of mental health problems in adulthood directly connected to an adverse childhood experience and mental health an increasing problem in society, working with children from an early age is key.

Vicky, family support worker at Kingsway Primary School, said: "Jess is absolutely amazing and inspirational to young people she turns up with a huge smile on her face and as soon as you see her you start to feel positive straight away. The children love Tuesday and really look forward to her coming in. Afterwards they are so happy and excited to tell us what they have done."

She continued: "Jess is fantastic with children she has the natural ability to put them at ease and happily chat away to her. Our children love positivity club and talk so much about it we have other children asking from other year groups if they can join in too."

Erin, class teacher at Hoylake Holy Trinity Primary School, said: "It is brilliant to offer Positivity Club to the children at Hoylake Holy Trinity. The values and skills that Jess teaches, through engaging and varied activities, are so important to our pupils."

She continued: "At our school we value the development of the whole child, and teach them to recognise and regulate their feelings and emotions – Positivity Club is the perfect after school club to support this. Jess is hugely knowledgeable and is a warm, engaging, ray of sunshine and we're very lucky to have her as part of our school community!"

In addition to the wonderful Positivity Club events, Jess also runs a child/parent group on a Friday at Equilibrium Northwest CIC in Birkenhead called Happy Minds and 1:1 sessions at ABC Children's Centre in Moreton and sessions in nurseries. She also runs Time For Tea adult support group every other Wednesday at 6.30pm at Lateral in West Kirby — improving the mental health of the wider community.



Positivity Club is delivered in pre-school nurseries and schools and also outside of school hours on Saturday mornings at St. Caths in Hoylake, on Wednesday afternoons at Holy Trinity in Hoylake, on Thursday afternoons at Corner House CIO in Birkenhead. Meanwhile, a Time For Teens group at St. Luke's in Hoylake works with teenagers.
