
Located on the corner of Inman Road, Cesar's Bistro offers classic English breakfasts, omelettes, lasagna, salads, lunches, steaks, specials, Sunday roasts and desserts with a unique South American twist. Having previously worked at restaurants across the city and recently based at The Rydal gym until it sadly closed, old customers and gym-goers have followed him to his new bistro.



Referred to as a 'wizard' and 'magician' by boxers and athletes at The Rydal gym, such is the quality of his food many of them now eat at his bistro daily. His culinary creations are simple yet high in protein and have his own unique spices and twists — as one diner recently said: "Cesar can make a piece of toast taste full of flavour!"



Cesar's journey to opening his own bistro hasn't been easy, however. A couple of years ago I had a heart attack, so when I went to look at a job at The Rydal gym I saw the potential to go back to catering and open up a little cafe in there. Everyone from the gym loved my food but sadly the gym closed last December."

He continued: "I was going to retire but someone from the gym said I could have their property off Linacre Road and encouraged me to open up here. I'm so glad that I did now, as many people from the gym have been loyal and followed me here for my food. Some come here every day. I work long hours here but I love it and there's a great sense of community. We have some amazing conversations in here."



Cesar's Bistro is open from Tuesday through until Sunday, from 8am and often into the evening. Whilst he works long hours there, his second wife Rebecca and his children are relieved that he gave up being a builder following his heart attack and decided to go back to the place he's happiest — in the kitchen cooking for people.

What followed was a strange sequence of co-incidences that made the move to Liverpool something they just had to do.



In this feature we bring you a little exclusive Q&A with 90s legends The Boo Radleys, who are celebrating 30 years of their No.1 album Wake Up, including the massive hit single Wake Up Boo! We talk to frontman Simon Rowbottom aka Sice about starting out in Wallasey and becoming Indie legends....



LVL: So, 30 years of that amazing album Wake Up! What do you have planned for it?

SICE: We've got a fair few gigs throughout the year. We're a little restricted as our bass player Tim is a teacher but we're packing a lot in. We've had gigs in Manchester, London and Glasgow and we had our 30th Anniversary gig at Rough Trade in Liverpool on 30th March where we played the whole Wake Up album at a gig for the first time. We've got festivals throughout the summer too, so it's a great year for sure.



LVL: How did it feel to be playing back in your home city?

SICE: It's always amazing coming back. Like a lot of people, we moved away from Liverpool and found ourselves in London. We get to see a lot of our family and old friends when we return so it's always a bit of a celebration coming home. It's always quite nostalgic too, as we used to play so many gigs in Liverpool when we were starting out.

LVL: How did you guys form back in the day?

SICE: We all grew up in Wallasey and New Brighton and all went to school together. We started playing together and doing local gigs at the likes of The Krazyhouse, Planet X and Yesterdays and things just naturally picked up. We started getting some London gigs and ended up getting dragged into the whole Britpop movement. It was such a wonderful way to spend our 20s and it was a bit of a whirlwind.

LVL: How did Wake Up Boo and the Wake Up album change your lives?

SICE: It changes your life enormously. The travel around to places such as the U.S and Japan and your lifestyle and job role completely changes. You can expect it to last forever but for most people it comes down and it's all about preparing for that. But the whole thing was incredible and changed all our lives.



LVL: Any moments that stand out for you in particular?

SICE: So many! Playing Glastonbury twice was amazing, playing such a large scale event! On the Holapalooza tour in the U.S we played some incredible venues such as The Gorge in Washington State which was based in a huge gorge like The Grand Canyon. Playing those kind of venues and getting to see the likes of Nick Cave, The Beastie Boys and Nirvana close up.

LVL: Are there any times where you've been a bit star struck or had a 'pinch me' moment?

SICE: Yeah loads of times! Being on Top Of The Pops with Stevie Wonder, hanging out with Radiohead and Oasis and people like that who are global stars. Just great memories to have and we're very grateful.



LVL: What are you doing outside of The Boo Radleys?

SICE: I'm a psychologist with my own private practise, helping people with their mental health. I'm also involved heavily in the Music Industry Therapist Collective — a project that offers mental health support to people in the music industry, led my psychologists who have been in the music industry before.

The downside about all the wonderful stuff I was saying is that the industry can be very exhausting and it can have a really effect on mental health. You can see the effects of the industry on artists such as burnout, alcohol and drugs and suicides.

So I spend time working for people in the industry, we go on tour providing support, run workshops and have therapists from around the world to help people in the industry. We're trying to change the culture and give people in the industry better education and support. I absolutely love being a psychologist and have found my calling outside music.







STAN & MARY

I love people's stories, and I heard one the other day I just had to put down in writing. I'm a great believer that there are stories everywhere if you have eyes to see and ears to listen. This one came second hand to me from someone who has those eyes and ears. I do some work in a nursing home and one of the girls who works there watches this story unfold every day...

Stan and Mary have been married for over fifty years, and now in the twilight of their lives they both have quite severe dementia. So much so that one does not know who the other is, and vice versa. Unable to care for themselves, they have both ended up in separate rooms in the same residential nursing home. Of a morning, Stan wakes around eight o'clock; he becomes restless, paces the floor, and is a little aggressive at times. It is as though something is troubling him, but he can't quite figure out what it is. He goes down to breakfast. Mary wakes a little later and comes for breakfast at around ten o'clock every day. When she enters the room, Stan's eyes light up; he goes from anxious to infatuated with this lady he thinks he has never set eyes on before, this lady that Stan thinks only just walked into his life that very morning. He rises to his feet and is drawn to her like a magnet, takes the seat closest to Mary at the table, and just stares at her in awe. His whole body language changes and a serenity envelops him as he takes his place by her side. It's as though he's found the lost piece of the jigsaw of his life that was missing when he climbed out of bed that morning, and he can now be at peace. If you ask Mary "Do you know who this man is?" she can't remember his name, but she goes bashful and coy, and starts to blush, she obviously still thinks that this man is very handsome. Mirroring this, Stan thinks she is the most beautiful lady he has ever laid eyes on. After breakfast, Mary moves to her armchair and Stan follows, like a shadow to Mary's form. They sit together all day, neither knowing who the other is,

neither knowing that they have a past together, or a family, or even where they are; they just know that they are in the right place when they are together. They get to fall in love for the first time every morning but then forget each other as they drift off to sleep each evening. Perhaps they merge lovingly into one another's dreaming. It's like a perpetual cycle of romance and forgetting. Mary took a fall a couple of weeks ago and bruised her arm quite badly, when Stan saw this, he kept holding her hand and kissing her arm for hours in an attempt to heal her.

My friend who witnessed this became quite overwhelmed and started crying. Presumed as maybe too sensitive by the other carers, she told me that she just couldn't understand why they couldn't all realise the enormity of what was occurring: how Stan and Mary were obvious proof that love is something that is beyond mind and knowledge. In her words, "That love is something spiritual". I think that's very true. I hypothesise that perhaps love is a frequency that is felt, witnessed and lived, rather than a thought or process. It is spiritual as she said, but maybe also chemical, sensory and intuitively led, certainly guided by a sixth sense that becomes awakened in the presence of a soul mate. Somebody said once that "love is hard" and I disagreed, relationships yes! But not love. It's the barriers inside us that make 'loving' hard, psychological memory being probably the greatest barrier. Emotional debris in the form of cardiac scars due to past hurts, resentment, bitterness and judgement, all causing resistance to us loving unconditionally. Psychological memory is what Stan and Mary seem to be totally free from, and just maybe, that makes their love even more beautiful than ours in a strange way, because they can love without memory or imagination, love in that very moment, every single day, from breakfast until bed.

A gem of a framing shop and art gallery in Hoylake is doing great work to support local artists. Hooked Up on Birkenhead Road offers gorgeous bespoke frames that help artists sell their work and also displays their work for sale in the shop — selling a few pieces a week for local artists.



Hooked Up was opened by art lover Sean Hughes in 2022, purely by chance. A granite and marble specialist and a top DJ for the likes of Cream, Sean's life changed forever when he visited the framing shop, then called Acorn, to choose a bespoke frame for his latest piece of art.



Sean got talking to the owner at the time, who told him he was going to retire after being there for years. He discovered that high street picture framing shops were a dying breed, largely due to cheap online offerings from the likes of lkea, but despite the risk he thought about it over Christmas and decided to buy the little business and save it.

It has proven to be a great move by art lover Sean. He changed the name to Hooked Up and decided to blend the shop with a gallery to display local artists' work and it's taken off big time! Three years later and he's busier than ever — working long days and seven days a week to keep up with art lovers' and artists' demand for his beautiful bespoke frames.



Sean explained: "In the modern age of internet shopping and rising costs, it's tough for little high street businesses. Big corporates come in and try to out-price them and take over the market. I used to love coming in to Acorn Framing to purchase a new frame for my latest piece of art, as I'd chat to the guy about art and you really got that personal touch."

He continued: "I felt quite sad to think that he'd be closing and it might not be there after he retired. I feel it's important to keep these little high street gems alive so after lots of thought I decided to quit my good job with my brother and take it on. It was a big risk but introducing a mini art gallery to help support local artists was a great move — they buy frames from me and I help them sell their work."



Hooked Up has developed a positive eco-system for art lovers and artists alike, whilst keeping the little high street business going — in a niche industry that's becoming more rare. Whilst Sean works long hours and often seven days a week, it's the connections with customers and artists and knowing he's saved a business that keeps him going.



Sean summarised: "I often leave here late at night but I love what I do. I love chatting with customers about art and creating the perfect bespoke frame for their piece of art, favourite photograph, portrait, poster, sports memorabilia, vinyls or anything else."

He continued: "I meet some cool artists and display some amazing work. It feels great knowing I've saved this little business — we need to keep places like this going otherwise we'll be living in a cold world of online shopping."

A Company Director has ditched the corporate life to open a 'gorgeous' independent book shop in New Brighton. Peter Frost, 56, has quit his role as Director of World Of Glass in St Helens and opened Messrs Fletcher & Frost Community Bookshop on Mount Pleasant Road — fulfilling a lifelong dream.



Returning to his hometown of New Brighton, Peter has opened a quaint little book shop that supports local authors and stocks a revolving range of 'hidden gems' — often one you won't find in large stores or supermarkets. Open Tues-Sat, 11am-5pm, Fletcher & Frost Community Bookshop also has a quirky little coffee shop at the back.



What really sets Peter's little book shop apart is the community ethos. With the aim of bringing people together through literary love, there are regular events such as Book Club and Poetry Club, monthly on Thursday evenings, Mums Club and Under 5s reading classes twice a month, Improving Confidence workshops and dementia sessions. Authors are also welcomed to host book launches.



Very much a passion project for Peter, Fletcher & Frost Community Bookshop aims to keep alive the local community book shop in a world that's dominated by retail and online giants. The idea is to offer the latest fiction and non fiction for adults and children, encourage local people to buy physical books from local authors and to read more, and also to bring people together.



Peter explained: "I am originally from New Brighton and have so many happy memories here from growing up. I spent years teaching before becoming a Director of a large glass company but have always loved books and it's always been my dream to open my own independent book shop. My father passed away recently and it made me realise that you only live once so it's important to follow your dreams."

He continued: "To come back home to New Brighton and open is very special. High street community book shops are a dying breed with online and retail giants, but there's something special about little independent book shops and buying a physical book. It's very much about community too — my regular events aim to connect people through the love of literature."



The regular events such as Book Club, Poetry Club, Mums Club, Under 5s reading classes, Improving Confidence workshops and dementia sessions aim to improve mental health and literacy, whilst combatting loneliness and isolation. Through Fletcher & Frost Community Book Shop, Peter has created more than just a book shop — it's a community hub.



Peter summarised: "It's very much a passion project for me. I have taken a big risk and decrease in income by quitting my role as Company Director but this isn't about money for me — it's much more than that. Since opening in April the feedback has been incredible — people love coming in and discovering some real gems and I've met some wonderful people in the shop. That makes it all worthwhile."



Peter Frost, 56, has opened Messrs Fletcher & Frost Community Bookshop at 51 Mount Pleasant Road in New Brighton — just a few doors down from The Telegraph Pub. The book shop offers gems from famous novelists alongside local authors and has regular clubs and classes. Peter also offers free delivery and special gift wrapping.



He continued: "Valediction Records is about how we deal with time passing, with growing older. Our regrets. Our losses. And how we cope with all of that. Some parts were emotionally tough to write, especially those dealing with mental illness and dementia. One of the characters suffers from depression, which I've dealt with on and off in my life. Another deals with dementia, something I've seen up close in my family. If you want to write something meaningful, you have to be brave and confront the darkness."



Now retired, Peter's creativity has hit new heights — from being a musician to recently Co-Writing and Producing the hit country musical theatre production Under The Mersey Moon that sold out The Floral Pavilion on multiple dates. He has now released his debut novel, Valediction Records, and is enjoying some incredible feedback from music and book lovers alike.



Peter summarised: "You've got to write a novel because you need to. Because it won't let you go. Valediction Records is about people bonded by music and the past, and what happens to them in life. It's emotional. The project's ongoing. Things are beginning to stir. That's all I can say. But I don't think you've heard the last of it."




A father-of-four from Ellesmere Port has become an acclaimed crime novelist after a 'horror fall' led him to become a writer. Michael Davies, 48, was left with 'life-changing' injuries after an accident but has now achieved global success with his crime thriller, The Veil Of Silence.



Set in Liverpool, Michael's gripping psychological thriller follows the story of hospital worker turned serial killer, Thomas Greene, and takes the reader on a fascinating journey through the twisted mind of a psychopath. The Veil Of Silence has received rave reviews on Amazon, Waterstones, WHSmith and other platforms and such is its success, Michael has been nominated for a Crimson Quill Award.

After its launch in November 2024, the first print run of The Veil Of Silence sold out in the UK within the first few months and with a new print run now arrived, a film of the novel is now in discussion too — with plans for filming in Liverpool in 2026. Michael also has two sequels in the pipeline — The Fractured Veil, due to be released later this year, and The Unravelled Veil to complete the trilogy.



Michael's overwhelming literary success is something he could never have imagined prior to March 2023, when he suffered a serious fall assisting with a road traffic accident whilst working for the NHS. The accident resulted in no feeling in one of his legs and one of his arms, leaving him resigned to a wheelchair and now a walking stick. Facing the darkest times of his life, he turned to writing as an outlet.



Michael explained: "I was rubbish at English in school and have since been diagnosed as autistic, which explains a lot about getting into trouble at school. I studied hard though and ended up having a good career in the NHS at The Countess Of Chester Hospital and Arrowe Park Hospital, becoming a family man too."

He continued: "Prior to 2023 I would've laughed at the idea of me being a novelist — that is, until I stayed late at work to help with a road traffic accident and fell onto some building materials in the dark. I suffered spinal and nerve damage and was left with no feeling in one arm and one leg — it was severely debilitating and I lost a lot of independence. During that time of darkness, I had to find something to do."



With lots of time on his hands and lots of time to think, Michael conceived a crime novel based on a hospital worker and so, The Veil Of Silence was created. Putting pen to paper, he spent his recuperation relentlessly writing his novel and rather impressively he has penned both his debut novel, the sequel and over 30 movie scripts in just two years. He now has huge plans in the pipeline.



Michael summarised: "What started as a hobby to keep my mind occupied has become a new career. The response to The Veil Of Silence has been overwhelming and sales have been flying in, so I'm now planning to release The Fractured Veil later this year. We have a film planned too that's set to be filmed in Liverpool in 2026."

He continued: "Life is very difficult since the accident. I am in constant pain and have to take morphine every day. If it wasn't for my family and writing I wouldn't be here and having something creative to focus on gets me through each day. It's all surreal how the book has taken off but if it wasn't for the accident I'd never have become a writer, so in a strange way I'm grateful for the accident."

In this regular La Vida Liverpool feature, guest writer and historian David Hearn educates us on some fascinating local history. With a wealth of knowledge, David gives talks and walking tours on subjects such as the history of Liverpool, wars, slavery, maritime, Liverpool's links with America and more. In this feature he talks us through the public art of Liverpool....

When we are in Liverpool city centre we always seem to be busy – trudging to work, shopping, meeting friends or any of a dozen other reasons but, if we take our time to look, Liverpool is a free open air art gallery. Let's have a quick look around the city centre to see if I can remind you of some things you may have seen before or show you some public art that you had not even noticed.



Over the arched window of the Lobster Pot opposite Central Station you can see a loaded camel lying down – ruined at some stage by brackets being fastened around it for a long lost sign. Williamson Street is a narrow street off Church Street but on the building at the corner of this street and Church Street you can see two white bas reliefs of twintailed mermaids holding sheets full of coins. These are by the great Liverpool sculptor Tyson Smith and the building was originally a bank designed by the world class Liverpool architect Herbert J. Rowse.



Very high on the Basnett Street wall of the TK Max shop there are a number of wonderful carvings but perhaps the most interesting one shows a First World War tank bristling with guns. Countless people walk past this every day, blissfully unaware of its existence.



Liverpool's Cenotaph in front of St George's Hall is accepted as one of the most prestigious war memorials in Britain. Designed by Lionel Budden of the University of Liverpool and with bas reliefs by Tyson Smith it manages to be both simple and dramatic at the same time.

On one face there are people mourning the loss of loved ones during the war – in the section shown here there are four people, the couple on the left appear to be wealthy and are dressed in fine clothes but the young woman third from left clearly cannot afford shoes and stands bare-footed. It didn't matter if you were a millionaire or poverty stricken the loss of a loved one was equally distressing.



It may sound like a silly question but where in Liverpool would you find a carving of some balls of wool and two knitting needles? The answer is on the Hope Street side of the building that is on the corner of Hardman Street and Hope Street. This building was once the School for the Blind and knitting is one of the skills that was taught there.



Even if UNESCO have removed Liverpool from the list of World Heritage Sites the City remains a "~Maritime Mercantile city" as proved on many buildings around the city and none more so that the magnificent portrayals of Mercury – the God of trade and commerce and Neptune – the God of the Sea which can be found on the front of the Adelphi Hotel.



The Spirit of Liverpool is almost always represented by a woman except, of course, the representation of Liverpool Resurgent on the former Lewis's building. This well known Liverpool landmark was created by Jacob Epstein but how many people walk past the three bas reliefs created by the same artist on the same building? The images of children were inspired by Epstein watching his grandchildren and their friends playing.



Not all art in Liverpool is "old" nor is it all formal, indeed in a city where the only people who walk alone are those who want to here is a message to the whole city from an unknown street artist. Simple and perhaps not the most sophisticate design, but nice all the same.



You may, or may not, be surprised to meet a walrus on a wall in Rainford Gardens off Matthew Street. Whilst revellers are living it up at The Cavern Club, The Grapes and many of the vibrant venues on the party street, taking photos with the Cilla statue, most of them will be unaware of this colourful character.




While I was wandering through Harrington Street looking for suitable images to photograph I suddenly became that I was being photographed myself. This image of Paul McCartney is by the talented local artist Paul Curtis.



The statue of Eleanor Rigby by Tommy Steele in Stanley Street sits on a bench and is a popular place for people to have their photographs taken but have you noticed that on the bench there is a carving of a copy of the Liverpool Echo and on top of that is a tiny bird?







A mother of two from Wirral is celebrating her travel agency business becoming a multi-million pound turnover company, just five years after she set up the business. Sorrel Ashton, 36, set up Sorrel Travel in March 2020, just before Covid lockdowns, but despite that has enjoyed £2.5 million in sales to date.

As a franchisee of Travel Counsellors, Sorrel offers her clients 'hidden gem' holidays — specialising in bespoke tailored holidays and drawing on her extensive knowledge of travel. Using agents on the ground all over the world, she supports local independents and provides boutique holiday experiences that most people wouldn't be offered using standard travel agents.

Sorrel gets paid a booking fee by suppliers and has a price parity with them, so she'll find the best deal for her customers and it doesn't cost them more to book through her. She takes the stress away from booking holidays and does all the work for the customer — like having a real life human expert with the reach of an online platform, yet without passing costs on.

Sorrel has developed a formidable reputation for customer service and going above and beyond, receiving a multitude of word of mouth referrals and becoming 'the go to girl' for unforgettable holidays of a lifetime. This has resulted in her hitting over £1 million in sales in 2024 and over £2.5 million since forming in 2020 — astounding considering there were two years of on and off lockdowns.

This achievement hasn't come without a great deal of stress however. Sorrel became a travel agent after hitting burnout balancing family life with her high pressure role as a Marketing Director for a global company. Then, just weeks after she launched her new business, Covid travel restrictions came in and her family had to rely on just one income.

I'd always have to rush to pick my kids up from school and they were often the last ones to be collected — not to mention the fact that I was always exhausted. This had a negative impact on us as a family."

She continued: "When I finally reached burnout and decided enough was enough, I took the leap of faith and fulfilled my dream of becoming a self-employed travel agent in March 2020. But then as we know, Covid travel restrictions came in and put all my business plans into disarray. My husband is a paramedic so was extremely stressed out anyway, never mind us struggling on one household wage."

As part of her business model Sorrel only gets paid when clients travel, therefore money was extremely tight for her and her family. Despite all the uncertainty, she kept the faith and continued to book holidays in the hope that travel restrictions would lift. Thanks to lots of hard work, when restrictions fully lifted she had developed a good enough reputation to hit the ground running and enjoy rapid growth.

Sorrel explained: "The travel industry is very competitive and I've only really had three full years as a business, so to become a multi-million pound turnover business already is something I'm really proud of. It's mostly down to my customer service — really getting to know people and the things they're looking for in a holiday and tailoring something magical to them."

She continued: "I always go the extra mile for people, whether that be arranging a rooftop proposal in Venice or a helicopter ride over The Rockies. I even managed to get one client a flight out of a war zone! I love what I do and making people's dreams come true! I've had to work really hard and have overcome adversities but I have so much more flexibility and time with my family now and that's priceless."

A couple who sold their home to set up a women's clothing brand have hit six figure sales in the first year. Amy Goodman and husband Marc sold their family home to create MELYR — a clothing brand designed to help women feel more comfortable, particularly those going through the menopause and changes in their body.

Most people wouldn't gamble their home to launch a fashion brand in midlife — especially not in the middle of menopause. But for Amy Goodman, the risk felt necessary. "I couldn't find a pair of trousers that didn't dig in when I sat down," she says. "Everything either clung in the wrong places or made me feel frumpy. I didn't want 'flattering' to mean hiding – I just wanted to feel good again."

So, in her mid-40s, Amy and her husband Marc made a bold decision: they sold their dream family home, and used the proceeds to launch a womenswear label designed for grown-up bodies and real-life dressing. One year later, their slow fashion start-up, MELYR, has quietly built a loyal UK following, shipping thousands of orders nationwide and passing six-figure sales in its first year of trading.

"It was terrifying," Amy admits. "We didn't have outside investment or a big team. Just a belief that we couldn't be the only ones fed up with how fashion made us feel." Marc, who spent years running Giancarlo Ricci, a successful menswear store on Liverpool's Bold Street, brought retail and operations expertise. Amy brought a lifetime of lived experience – and a deep understanding of how style impacts self-worth, especially in the messy middle of life.

From a small warehouse in Birkenhead, the couple began designing clothes with stretch, movement and confidence stitched into every seam – timeless pieces that move with the body, rather than working against it. Amy didn't set out to be the face of the brand. But what started as a personal frustration has become something bigger – a brand built on real women, stories, and bodies that shift with age, hormones, and experience.

"We've had women write to us saying they feel like themselves again," she says. "That something actually fits. They wore our trousers to a big meeting and didn't think about their waistband once. Those messages mean everything." MELYR's collections are small, slow and made with care – from responsibly sourced fabrics to inclusive UK sizing. But perhaps what's most refreshing is what they're not trying to be: not trend-led, not youth chasing.

As one customer recently said: "Like many women, my shape has changed in the past five years. Finding a top that works with my midriff without drowning me was impossible – until now. In my mind, MELYR nailed it."

With a growing community, 5-star reviews across Trustpilot and social media, and nearly 50,000 Instagram followers, the brand is picking up momentum – but Amy is clear that her mission hasn't changed. She explains: "I didn't do this to be an influencer. I did it because I needed clothes that understood me. With a business background in health foods, holistic therapies and sports nutrition followed by a degree in biomedical sciences and 15 year career in the NHS as a Paramedic and later as a Physician Associate, Amanda started exploring solutions.

The greatest gift La Vida Liverpool has given me is friendship and thanks to this magazine I have met some truly wonderful people during the past seven years. One of those people is Icelandic life coach Linda Baldvinsdottir and we have worked together on some beautiful collaborations, including our Happiness Podcast.

In January 2025 she visited Liverpool with her fantastic partner Björgvin and it was great to show them around — including a historic pub crawl. In May 2025 they returned the favour in a massive way as I stayed with them in Iceland — a four day whirlwind of exploration, nature, culture and connection.



I flew out on Sunday morning (just £200 through Easyjet and there are now flights from Liverpool too) and arrived at midday after less than three hours in the air. I was greeted by my two dear friends and glorious sunshine — the weather was exceptional during my stay and was, in fact, one of the hottest few days in May on record.

Whereas Icelandic winters are long and dark with only three hours of daylight most days, the spring and summer days are the exact opposite — with very little darkness at night — yet often rainy and very rarely above 20 degrees. I was extremely lucky to experience some incredible weather during my visit!



The Icelandic weather saved its best for me, it seemed, and an epic mini-adventure commenced from the moment I arrived. I was met at the airport by the warm, welcoming smiles of Linda and Björgvin and was whisked away on an awe-inspiring road trip straight away!

The first thing that struck me was the barren, rugged and other-worldly terrain, before driving through Grindavik — a small town located perilously in a danger zone with the threat of an earthquake at any time. Only the brave, stubborn and foolish remained living in the mostly abandoned town.



We travelled along many winding roads as I looked out of the window in awe at the alien landscape, with mountains bearing down on us wherever we were, before reaching our next destination. The blue lagoon at Kerið was truly breathtaking, whether admiring it from above or at surface level, and I managed to capture a beautiful photograph of my hosts at the basin of the lagoon.



We then visited Friðheimar or 'World Of Peace' — a famous tomato plantation and eatery that sells THE best tomato soup imaginable! Not to mention tomato beer, tomato cocktails, tomato ice cream and pretty much anything you can think of using tomato as the main ingredient. It was here that the reality of the cost of things in Iceland dawned on me — all I can say is that most things are double the cost of the UK so basically, take twice the spending money you'd usually budget for.



As we travelled further along the mesmerising land, Linda and Björgvin answered my endless questions about their country. They told me about their menacing volcano Eyja Fjalla Jokull (I still can't pronounce it, even after Linda buying me a mug with its name on) — a volcano that erupted in the 1700s and caused widespread deaths in Iceland and as far as in Europe. It was a stark reminder of the power of nature in this surreal country.



The next stop on our epic road trip was Seljalandsfoss and gljúfrabüi waterfalls — powerful and beautiful in equal measure, with a rainbow posing perfectly across them for a photograph. We explored the caves and waterfalls that gushed into them — the sheer beauty of nature at its finest!



We then headed to the capital, Reykjavik — a quaint and charming little harbour city with lots of cool bars and restaurants. If you visit one of the bars, be sure to play 'Spin The Wheel' where you can win up to 10 beers for the price of two — saving you a fortune if you win — although on second thoughts, don't listen to me!



Linda and Björgvin were the best hosts and I managed to get a few hours sleep despite it never truly getting dark. The following day, we visited the outdoor baths — a popular concept in Iceland (their tiny little hometown of Hafnarfjörður 20 minutes outside of Reykjavik has three) — where showering before entering is both mandatory and customary. It's these little things that set countries apart — I mean, could you imagine public outdoor baths in the UK? Absolute carnage for sure and good luck policing the hygiene rules!



We then embarked upon another epic road trip that I will never forget! Once again, the striking landscape captivated me as we travelled along roads that felt like they shouldn't be there — man-made concrete paths built for vehicles on an island where nature is at its most dominant.



Let's be truthful here, there's only one winner in this battle and visiting the Gullfoss waterfall was a stark reminder of that — the sheer power and sound of the water was breathtaking and the thought of falling in was extremely humbling. I think we all need that realisation sometimes — that nature always wins and there is a greater force that rules us.

We next visited the Geysirs — spectacular and strange in equal measure. Yet again, nature showcasing its sheer strength and dynamism — this time through both heat and water. There really isn't a country like the 'land of fire and ice' and despite there being long, dark and bleak winters, Iceland remains one of the happiest countries on earth.

Linda and Björgvin taught me a saying, betta reddast (pronounced Theta Reddast), which essentially means 'we've been through so much already, so everything is going to be alright'. I think the fact that Icelanders have survived, thrived and become happy on and island that's constantly under threat from volcanos and earthquakes is a most inspiring example of the strength of human spirit and this quote will remain instilled within me forever.



We enjoyed pizza and pints at one of their popular food halls before watching the stunning midnight sunset over the golf course and ocean in their picturesque hometown. Apparently, such is the light in the summer, they have golf tournaments that go on through the night!



The sunset was one of the best I've witnessed anywhere on the planet and I managed to sleep well again despite it being pretty much constantly daytime and never truly getting dark — I attribute that to the epic road trips, lots of conversation and laughter and one or two beers, of course.



On the third day I did a little work (this positive news machine won't run itself) before exploring Linda and Björgvin's hometown — a peaceful little fishing village where everything is so different, from the buildings to the way of life. The air is so clean and everything seems so basic, simple and relaxed.



I particularly enjoyed a couple of pints with Björgvin at a rather plush restaurant and bar overlooking the harbour — before being treated by Linda to the most spectacular lamb dinner. You know, I think it pays to be a good person — it can result in meeting friends for life from Iceland who take hospitality to another level!



As if things couldn't get any better, my gorgeous hosts whisked me away to the Sky Lagoon for a unique and invigorating experience. We enjoyed a few drinks in the giant hot tub overlooking the ocean and indulged in a spa journey — a delight for the soul, yet what filled me with the most joy was my connection with Linda and Björgvin. With every conversation our connection became stronger and I will forever cherish these very special days we shared together.



To end this whirlwind four day VIP tour of such an awe inspiring country, Linda and Björgvin took me to Fly Over Iceland — a simulator attraction in Reykjavik that takes you on a virtual reality flight over the country. We experienced a brief tour that delved into the history and culture of Iceland before embarking upon an immersive journey above the majestic island.

As incredible as it was, the thing that struck me the most was that during the cultural tour the words betta reddast were mentioned by the mystical troll narrating on the large screen. This cemented my admiration for this country and its people — an island dominated by nature yet a place where the hardy and positive can thrive.

My adventure was complete with a few drinks in Reykjavik at a couple of the bars located on the city centre square — a very cultured and sophisticated city centre square in my eyes — before heading to one of Reykjavik's highest rated restaurants. The Icelandic capital is renowned for its fine dining and grillmarkaðurinn, The Grill Market, was certainly up there as one of the best dining experiences I've had in my life!



I was tempted to opt for something exotic such as puffin, reindeer or whale but was delighted with our set menu choice! The cool, basement setting played host to a fiesta of flavours, as we enjoyed a trio of seafood starters, the finest steak I've tried in a long time and heavenly desserts alongside silky smooth Malbec — every bite and every sip a sensation!



What made this dining experience so special was, of course, the company. Linda and Björgvin truly excelled themselves during these four days — both as hosts and as human beings. Linda, a wise, strong and motherly life coach paired with Björgvin, a calm, dependable and good man with a mischievous sense of humour, make a perfect couple and I am honoured to have been their guest on this adventure. And do you know what makes this story even more special?



I write this article having just received the incredible news that Linda and Björgvin have got married — a private affair announced to an outpouring of love on social media! Having shared unforgettable memories with this beautiful couple — first in Liverpool followed by my adventure of a lifetime in Iceland — I am absolutely delighted for them both from the bottom of my heart. To be a part of your journey is an honour and to be invited to your big wedding celebration party in October even more so — it seems there are more Icelandic adventures to come!

Sue King is a highly respected figure in the martial arts community and the highest-ranking active female Japanese Ju-Jitsu practitioner in the UK. A Shihan, 7th Degree Black Belt, and dedicated Buddhist, Sue has also served as the Regional Officer for Ju-Jitsu in Liverpool. As the founder and owner of Team Mushin CIC, she passionately dedicates her life to empowering both children and adults, helping them improve their lives through the transformative practice of Ju-Jitsu.



Her school and Community Interest Company in Norris Green has saved countless children from lives of crime — getting kids 'off the street and into the gym' and there have been too many success stories to mention. Sue and her team instil key values and ethics into the pupils — using Sue's personal experiences as inspiration to show what's possible.

As featured by the Liverpool Echo, BBC Radio Merseyside, BBC North West Tonight, BBC News and BBC Sportsday, Sue's story has touched many people. As a child, Sue's mother died when saving her from a house fire — a tragedy that caused skin grafts that made her a target for childhood bullies. She then grew up as the sole carer for her seriously ill father, who was in hospital during the fire.

Sue started self-defence classes while in high school to deal with bullies and said it gave her "an escape from my reality, from home". Her father died in 2008, leaving her with funds she used to open her Ju-Jitsu school to give children a safe space to learn and has since dedicated her life to giving them better lives. Taking this one step further, she is now sharing her skills, knowledge and experiences across the globe.

Sue explained: "The past 12 months have been nothing short of incredible. Our gym has gone from strength to strength, with new classes added to support our growing community. We're especially proud of how our children's classes have thrived. I resumed training BJJ with my lifelong friend and Mushin coach, Steven Hughes. Our Ju-jitsu journey spans over 30 years, and it's been deeply rewarding to train with him again."

"Unfortunately, early on in the year I faced a significant challenge — a knee injury sustained during training that sidelined me for many months, preventing me from training and attending some UK seminars. While it was a difficult period, it reminded me of my motto of triumph over adversity and the importance of resilience and adaptation, values I strive to share with our students."

"I was joined on these trips by my uchideshi Sean who travelled with me as my uke and his assistance was invaluable in delivering these seminars. Next year I'll be teaching and speaking in the UK alongside seminars in Norway, Belgium, Munich, and Portugal."
